Class Fees: Leadline - \$5, Equitation - \$15, All others \$25

Awards: Ribbons awarded to 6th place in each class/division.

Classes: Current USDF/USEF/WDAA tests will be used. ADA points only count for USDF classes only.

Rule Adherence: USDF and WDAA rules apply. Horses may not show in more than 3 classes per day excluding equitation and leadline. Show management reserves the right to limit number of classes for the welfare of the horse.

Entries: Entries and payment information to be announced! Complete entries must be received by the closing date. Entries will be accepted in the order received until the show is full, then entries are placed on a waitlist. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide, combine or cancel classes where appropriate. Each entry must be signed by the rider and the parent if necessary. It must

also include proof of a negative coggins within 12 months of show date. Name on the Coggins must match the name of the horse on the entry form. **Post Entries** will be accepted, at the discretion of the show committee, for an additional fee of \$15 per class. **Refunds** Exhibitor withdrawal for any reason prior to the closing date will be refunded minus the office fee. Waitlisted entries will receive a full refund if not accepted. Cancellations must be made *in writing via email* to the show secretary. No refunds after the closing date.

Confirmation & Ride Times: Ride times will be emailed to each exhibitor three days prior to the show date. They will also be posted on Facebook under Shrine Horse Show Columbia City. Please include an email address for ride times to be sent to. Ride times may change, check the day sheets for confirmed times. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Changes need to be requested in writing to the show secretary. Day of changes will be honored to the extent possible.

No Shows: All “no shows” that have not contacted the show office, will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and their time slots may be filled by other exhibitors. No refunds will be given after the show closing date. Exhibitors entering the show do so with this understanding and agreement.

Attire: ASTM/SEI helmets with fastened chin straps must be worn at all times when mounted. Show attire is not required. Helmets (Required), boots, breeches and schooling attire are permitted.

Dressage Bridle Numbers: Bridle numbers must be worn at any time the horse is out of its stall.

Scores and Test Sheet Pick Up: You should be able to check your score within 45-60 minutes of completion of your class. Test sheets are usually available for pickup after the class results and placings are posted. **No** tests can be returned until the entire class is completed, scored, and results posted.

Classes/Arena: Current USDF/USEF/FEI/WDAA tests will be used. Classes will run in a 20 x 60 ring unless stated otherwise. Footing in the competition ring a mixture of sifted soils and sand. The warm-up and lunging areas are grass. For safety reasons, exhibitors are reminded not to lunge horses in any areas other than the lunging area.

Closed Rings: Any closure to the competition ring will be announced. Horses and handlers are not permitted in arenas when equipment is being used or a course is being set for an upcoming class. Violation of the above **MAY** be considered cause for elimination from the show.

Stabling: \$65 weekend/\$45 day, \$15 refund for stripping stall. Bedding is available for pre-purchase at \$7/bag and must be purchased 30 days prior to the show. All reservations are taken on a first come first served basis. No stalls will be reserved until payment has been received. No refunds 30 days prior to the show.

Campers: Campers may be dropped off after 2 pm Thursday August 18. Electric Hookups will not be available until Friday August 19. Campsites include 30A and 50A hookups; please make sure you bring the correct plug size/type and an extension cord rated for your usage level. Campers hooked up to electricity will be charged \$40 per weekend / \$25 Daily. Payment must be received prior to electrical hookup.

Facilities: Restrooms and on-site concessions available.

Departure: All horses and trailers shall leave the Shrine grounds no later than 7 pm Sunday August 21.

Liability Releases: No numbers or ride times will be released until all liability forms, both those of the sanctioning body and the show grounds, are signed. Photography releases must also be signed and returned to the Show Secretary.
