No audio or video recorded meeting.

Open to the Public: Mike Bergbigler asked the regulations on placing a mobile home on lot.

Old Business:

The minutes from the May meeting were read. Don made a motion to approve the minutes. Tyler seconded. Carried.

We received a quote from Williams & Willman for the double line painting on Herman Road at \$\$4,224.00. This hasn't been done previously and will be costly to upkeep each year. Don made a motion to not place lines on Herman Road. Dave seconded. Carried.

New Business:

The treasurer's report was read. General Fund \$112,289.23. Deposits \$75,119.26. Disbursed \$36,708.10. Ending \$150,700.38.. State Fund \$309,922.18. Deposits \$13.69. Disbursed \$.00. Ending \$309,935.87. Sewage Fund \$10,907.33. Deposits \$.48. Disbursed \$960.00. Ending \$9,947.81. Capital Reserve Fund \$381,172.72. Deposits \$32.37. Disbursed \$0.00. Ending \$381,205.09. Equipment Fund \$67,262.68. Deposits \$2,502.93. Disbursed \$.00. Ending \$69,765.61. Building Fund \$70,812.31. Deposits \$1,002.72. Disbursed \$13,870.00. Ending \$57,945.03. Traffic Light Fund \$37,051.67. Deposits \$.94. Disbursed \$.00. Ending \$37,052.61. Don made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Dave abstained. Tyler seconded. Carried.

Don made a motion to approve transferring from General Fund-\$2,500 to Equipment Fund, \$1,000 to Building Fund, and \$500 to Money Market. Tyler seconded. Carried.

Discussed placing \$50,000 into a CD. It was tabled for next month's meeting when we will know more interest rates.

Don made a motion to submit the 2025 delinquent Per Capita Tax to Statewide Tax Recovery for collection. Dave seconded, Carried.

Don made a motion to approve \$10,000 matching funds towards DCED Multi Modal CFA grant for Clearfield Road Phase 2 of milling, asphalt, and seal coat. Tyler seconded. Carried.

Don made a motion to approve Resolution 06-26-01 DCED Multi Modal CFA Grant request in the amount of \$984,963.00 for the milling, asphalt, and seal coat of Clearfield Road(s) Phase 2. Tyler seconded. Carried.

Discussed the if yellow lines on Clearfield Road at 422 were needed. Dollar General initially placed these lines as one time placement. They are fading and according to PennDOT specs, if it is sealed, the lines are not required to be placed and sealing would not be costly. Don made a motion to seal coat and not replace lines. Dave seconded. Carried.

Clearfield Road(s) bid for pipe and inlets were discussed. Dave read the letter from McKinney Hauling & Excavating, Inc formally requesting to withdrawal/rescind their bid due to an error in their bid that did not comply with the special provisions of the contract. Tyler made a motion to accept their withdrawal and award this bid to Bauer Excavating for \$548,838.00. Dave seconded. Carried.

Planning Commission:

Don made a motion to approve the Geibel Family Trust subdivision pending DEP Sewage Component Module approval.
Don made a motion to approve the Geibel Family Trust Sewage Component Module. Dave seconded. Carried.

Don made a motion to approve the J Fisher subdivision pending DEP Sewage Component Module approval.
Don made a motion to approve the J Fisher Sewage Component Module. Dave seconded. Carried.

Building and Sewage Permits: 2 building permits were issued s garage and deck.

With no further business, Don made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dave seconded. Carried.
