Easter Greetings In His Name,

Today is designated as Good Friday – the day that Jesus went to the CROSS, to pay our sin debt. That designation, on the surface, seems to be a contradiction. Especially, since it designates the day that Jesus was crucified. Usually, we don't look upon the death of a loved one as "good." On the contrary, we grieve and mourn. And this past year have brought us much grief and much mourning. But there is a reason that we refer to this day as "Good Friday", and one of the most beloved scriptures in the Bible explains it best: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)
