WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Bellmont employees an assessor who is at the same time employed by another another assessing unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Town Board of the Town of Bellmont does hereby rescind all prior resolutions, motions and or Local Laws relating to the establishment of date, time and place for the Board of Assessment Review to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

2. That pursuant to Section 512 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, as amended, the Town of Bellmont, does hereby designate the Friday next following the fourth Tuesday of May of each year, commencing with May 1996, from the hours of 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM and from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM, and for so many days and or hours thereafter as the Board of Assessment Review deems necessary in order to complete its hearing of complaints in relation to assessments.

3. This local law shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until rescinded or superceded by subsequent local law.

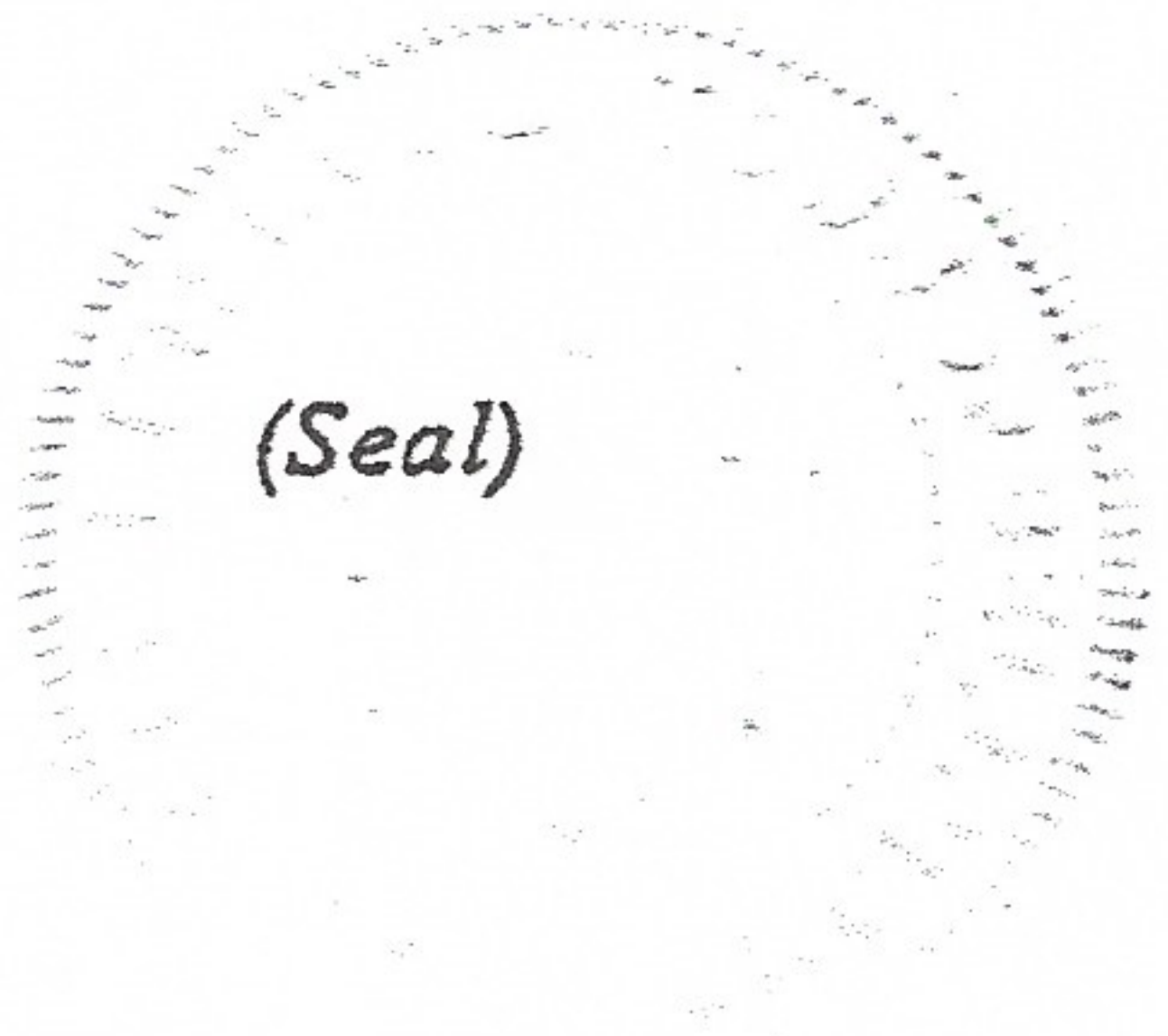
