SPECIALTY SHOOT STRUCTURE

Dear GTSL Shooters:

Another GTSL season is almost complete. As you may have noticed, we will only be hosting one post season shoot this year opposed to the traditional three post season shoots. At the end of the 2022-2023 season, former GTSL President, Fran Kosmacki, GTSL officers, and club representatives voted to host one big post season shoot. Over the past few years, we have had lower attendance at post season shoots for various reasons and have decided to try something new.

We understand the importance and tradition of the Golden Triangle Skeet League, so we have designed the post season shoot to include the previous 5-man team, 2-man team and individual shoots. On the next page, you will find the breakdown of each event.

One thing you may notice is the post season shoot fee. For the specialty shoot only, the fee is \$20 and not \$15. The \$20 includes 50 targets and the 5-man team event that everyone will participate in. If shooters wish to participate in the 2-man team event, there is an additional \$5 fee per shooter. The additional money will be used for GTSL prizes. Elite Shotguns has generously donated a few prizes so thank you Elite.

5-Man Team:

- Traditionally, the 5-man teams were chosen by each club representative. There were three teams: scratch, handicap, and club (class).
- We will continue to have three 5-man teams; however, teams will be chosen based on your posted score the day of the specialty shoot.
 - Scratch Team
 - Top 5 scratch scores from each club. Ties will be determined by long run.
 - Handicap Team
 - Top 5 handicap scores from each club. Ties will be determined by highest scratch score. If ties are still present, determination will be by long run.
 - Honorable Mention
 - The next 5 highest handicap scores after the handicap team have been determined. Ties will be determined by highest scratch score. If ties are still present, determination will be by long run.

2-Man Team (Additional \$5 fee):

- The 2-man team structure will remain the same as before. You can choose to shoot with or without your partner even if you shoot on different squads, you're scores will still be added together. We will be running full 5-man squads. Let us know who your partner is if you choose to participate in this event.
- Teams will be classed 1-6 based on overall team average.

Individual Shoot

- The individual shoot structure would remain the same. There would be an HOA Scratch Champion, HOA Handicap Champion, and Class scratch and handicap champions.
- We will continue to do the handicap shootoff to determine HOA Handicap champion, class scratch champions, and class handicap champions.

NOTE: Please bring extra shells in case you are in a shootoff. If you cannot stay, please let us know so we can plan accordingly.
