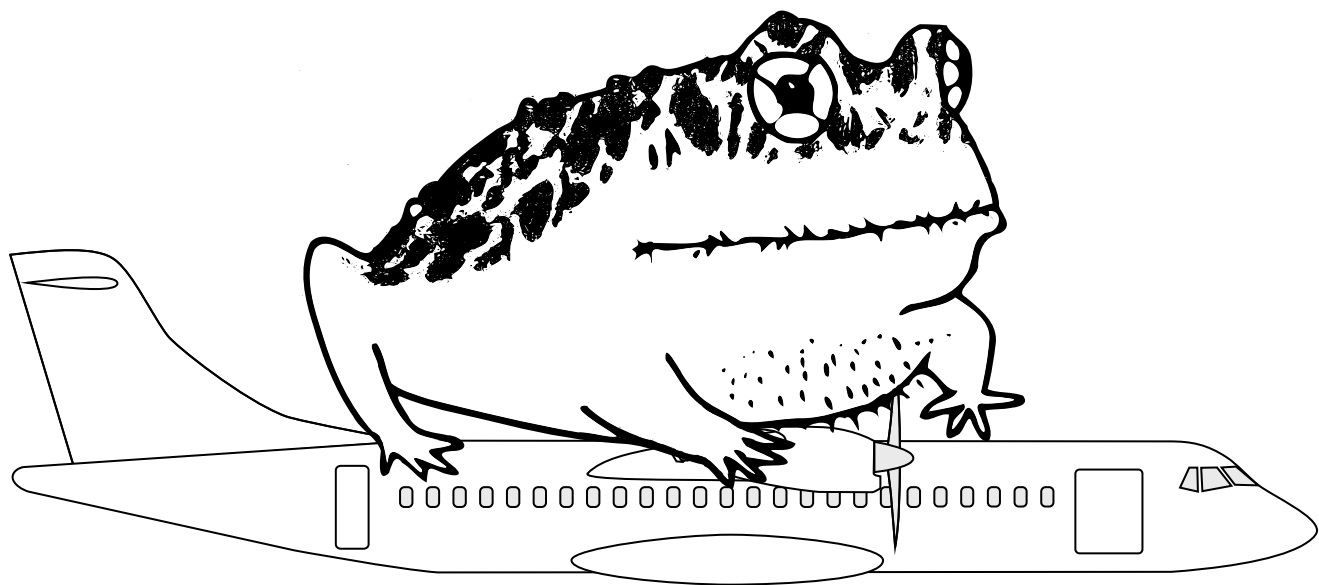

Help Musa eat a delicious baby dinosaur by solving this maze.



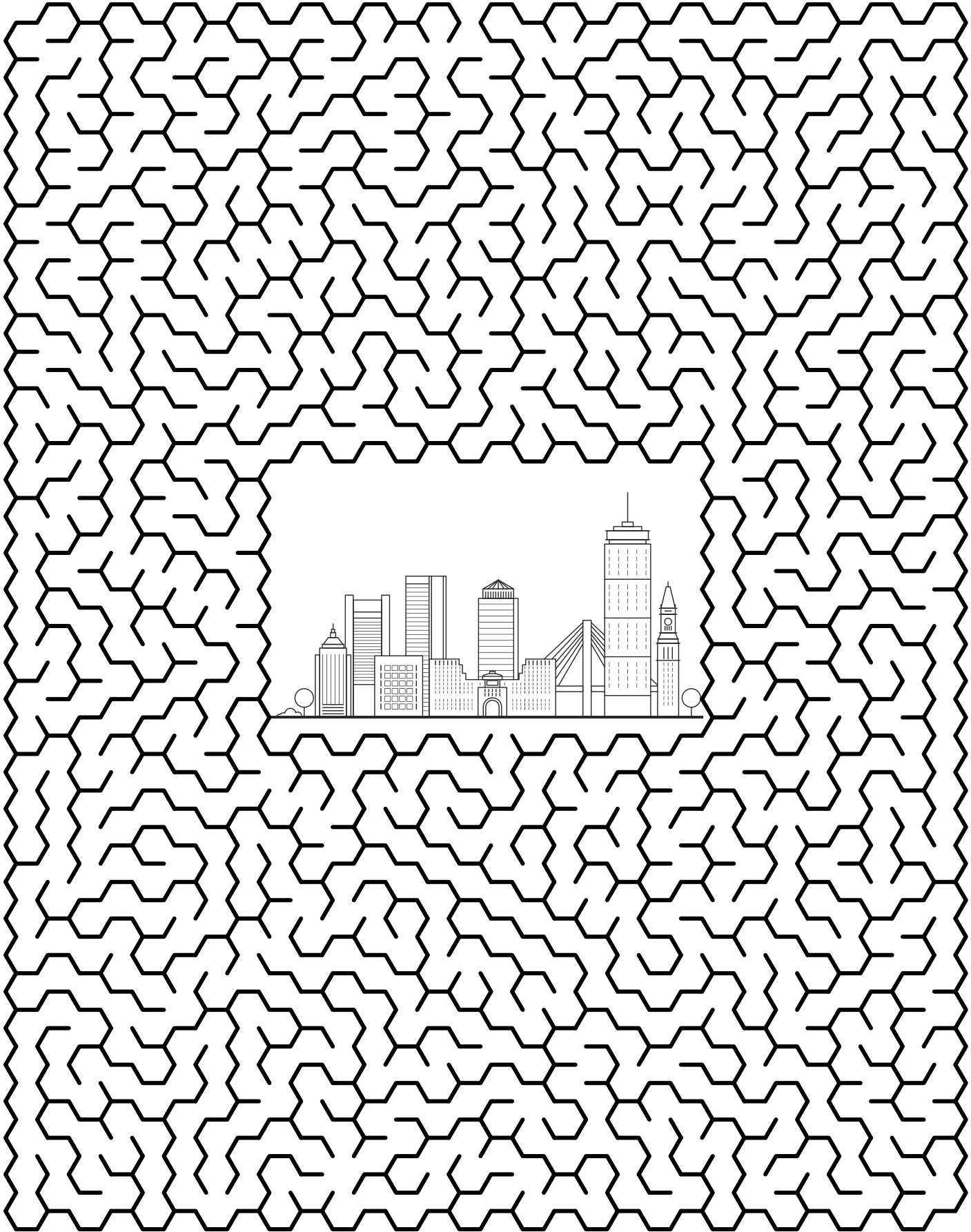

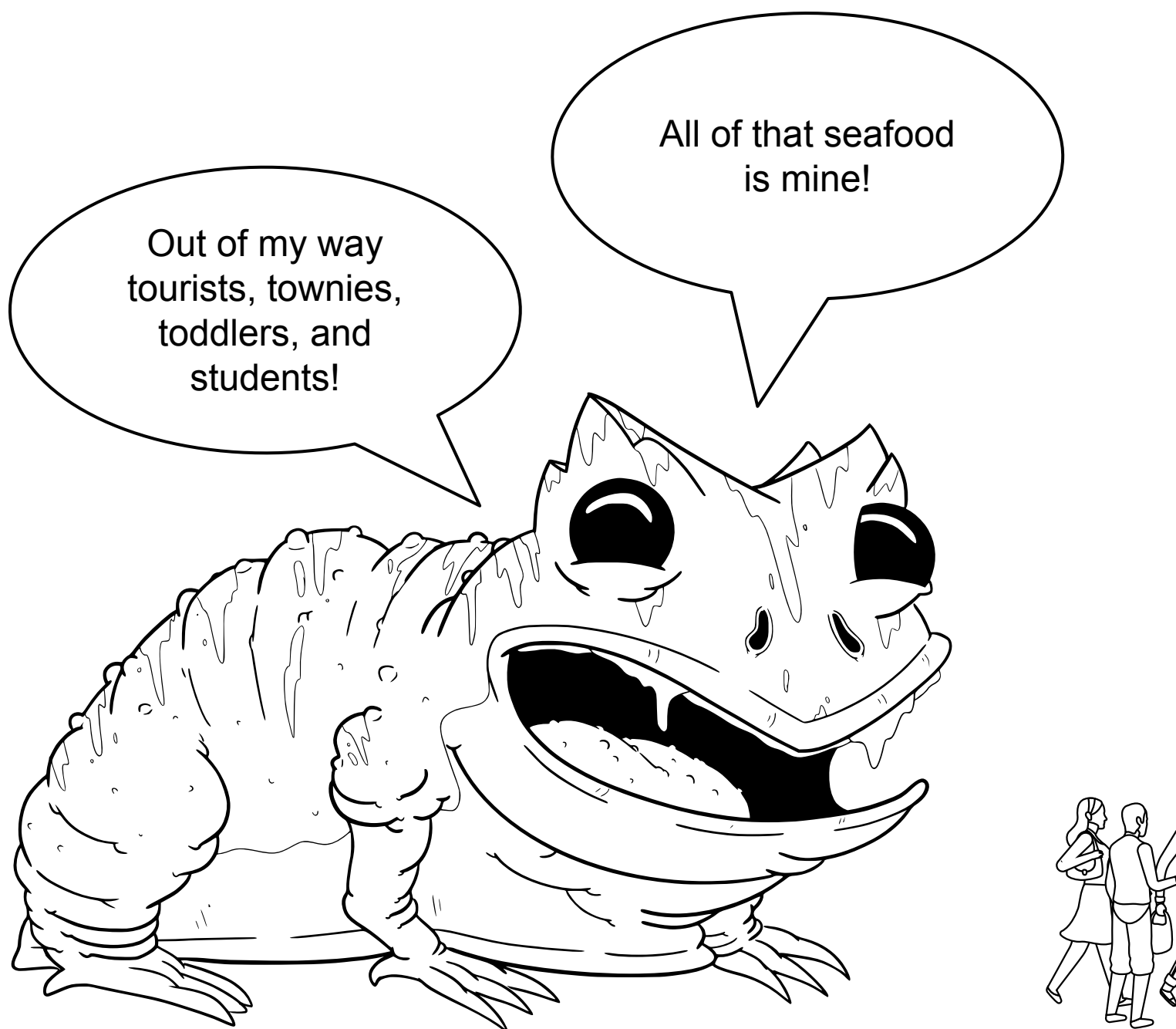
