Announcing the fourth “running” of The Tusenbeiner, a 2K and/or 5K fun run walk on Saturday, July 18. Tusenbeiner means thousand legs. Last year we had 80. We hope for at least 120 this year.

The activity starts at 8:30 in the Mayo parking lot a little west of and across the street from the Ager Museum. Registration online at agerhouse.org. Register by July 13 to be sure to get a Tusenbeiner T-shirt.

This activity is in keeping with the mission of the Association, which includes *livreise* (the effort to understand one’s own journey and culture and that of one’s ancestors) and *friluftsliv* (open air living and activity). A run or walk (or bike) on city trails in Eau Claire is a good way to enjoy the outdoors.

Now is a good time to get your *beiner* moving, even if you aren’t planning to ski in the American Birkebeiner (birch legs) next winter.

AND--this event ends with a light Scandinavian “brunch” and a chance to make new friends.

The fun run/walk is sponsored by the Waldemar Ager Association and Museum and its supporters. Money not used for expenses go the Ager’s capital campaign. The Association envisions a center for Nordic culture on land just east of the museum, facing Whipple and West Madison Streets.
