Applied assignment and completion time

Create a basic chart report identifying the asset, timeframe, market direction, recent high and low, and two support and resistance areas. Allow approximately 2 additional hours for the assessment and assignment.

Candlestick & Price Action Analysis

Read the information contained in candle bodies, wicks and confirmation.

Applied assignment and completion time

Annotate a portfolio of candlestick examples, including valid and failed patterns, and explain how location and confirmation affected each reading. Allow approximately 2-3 additional hours.

Understand how price moves between structural and liquidity areas.

Map market structure and liquidity on historical charts, including the liquidity pool, sweep, structural break, invalidation and target. Allow approximately 2 additional hours.
