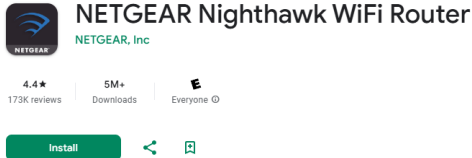


Resetting your Netgear Network

First, install the Netgear app on your phone.

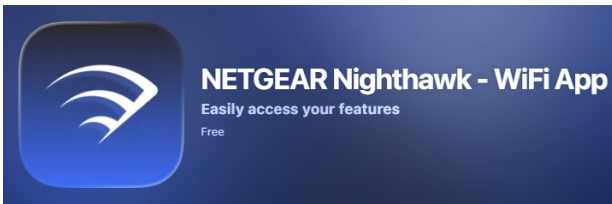

Setup Instructions — App Setup

1. Make sure you are connected to the WiFi that your router is broadcasting.
2. Next, go to your web browser, and type 192.168.1.1. A login prompt will appear, enter admin for the username, New1212! For the password.
3. You now have access to change the settings of the router nodes, if you wanted to change your WiFi's name, you'd go to the wireless section in the top left and change it in there.
4. If wanting the 30-day trial of "Netgear ARMOR" interests you, continue with the App Setup.

Download and open the Netgear app, check the circle to accept their Terms And Conditions, then press I agree. Enable notifications if interested, provides outage and update notifications. Enable wifi auto-connect for a better connection to the router.

Next, you will be creating an account, or logging into an existing one. If you don't have one, select, "I don't have an account". If you do, select log in. Proceed with account setup.

Once logged in, the app will search for your router. Make sure your phone is still connected to your router's WiFi, then follow the on-screen prompt to let the app find your network. When your Nighthawk router (and any add-on nodes/satellites) appears, tap it to connect.

The app will check for a firmware update. If one is available, allow it to install. Keep the app open and your router powered on until it finishes. The router may reboot during this step, which is normal.

To change your WiFi name or password, open the menu and go to WiFi Settings. Enter your new network name (SSID) and password, then save. Your devices will need to reconnect using the new info.

If you'd like to try Netgear ARMOR (security/anti-virus protection), the app will offer a 30-day free trial. Select Start Free Trial to enable it, or skip this step to set it up later under the Security tab. Note: ARMOR requires a paid subscription once the trial ends.
