Vineland City Hall Fourth Floor Non-Friable Floor Tile and Mastic Abatement

Preparations & Removal Procedures

The following procedures detail non-friable asbestos removal activities to take place in the Vineland City Hall Building, fourth floor.

The scope of the abatement will proceed as follows:

- 1. All floor tile and mastic removal shall be performed using methods that will **not** render the tiles or mastic friable.
- 2. Each removal area will be isolated from non-removal areas using 6-mil polyethylene sheeting and triple flaps over the entry to the work area. Polyethylene sheeting shall also cover all penetrations into the work area and ventilation registers. Ventilation shall be turned off while the room is isolated. A three-chamber decontamination unit will be installed.
- 3. Negative air filtration will be established in the work area to minimize the potential of fiber migration from the work areas to non-work areas. The number of negative air filtration units shall be sufficient to assure the work area is under negative pressure.
- 4. All non-permanent sectional walls shall be removed AFTER negative pressure to the area has been established and will be performed in a manner that will not cause floor tile to become friable. The wall sections may be disposed of as non-asbestos waste.
- 5. Non-friable asbestos containing floor tile will be removed as detailed by the Resilient Floor Covering Institute's "Recommended Work Practices for Removal of Resilient Floor Coverings" and the New Jersey Department of Health & Senior Services document "A Contractor's Guide For The Non-Friable Removal of Asbestos Containing Floor Tiles". The Contractor's Guide Document is attached for review.

Only the use of tile heating machines will be acceptable.

6. Asbestos containing floor tile mastic shall be removed by use of a solvent-based mastic removal.

The type of mastic remover shall be "High Flash, NO ODOR". There will be no exceptions.

Only the use of non-mechanical mastic removal methods will be acceptable.

All isolation barriers are to remain in place until successful final air testing results are achieved.
