Please confirm if there is existing electric or plumbing in the slab. Will x-ray of the slab be required for saw cutting purposes?

Yes there is plumbing and electrical in the slab.

The installing contractor must utilize x-ray imaging techniques to confirm the routing of the existing under-slab sanitary piping and to avoid conflicts with under-slab electrical conduits during floor cutting and trenching activities. The contractor must procure the services of a qualified subcontractor to execute the x-ray imaging services. For bidding purposes, the contractor should assume that trenching and floor cutting/restoration activities will include up to 50 linear feet of trenching, 2 foot wide x 6 feet deep.

Doors 1/B1-15C and 1/B1-15E call for Access Control (Banana Cable) to be coiled above the ceiling as spares. Should an additional LNL-1320-S3 reader expander module be included to support future card access?

The new panel should support/provide space for an additional board, but no 1320 board is required

9 Question & Answer

On drawing A-1 there is a note to provide conduit for new hardware at the existing to remain storefront Door 1/B1-16A and an existing unmarked double entrance door. Please confirm conduit to the unmarked door will not be required as new hardware is not indicated.

Yes, the conduit is required.

10 Question & Answer

Drawing E-1 notes a new horn-strobe and card reader at the existing to remain storefront system, please confirm if these devices and associated conduits are intended to be surface mounted to the storefront.

The card reader/keypad will mount on the storefront system, the wires should be run within, no surface mounted wiring.

The horn-strobe to be mounted on the corner post and wiring to run within the post.



11 Question & Answer

This project indicates a project duration of 90 days with liquidated damages. Please confirm that the inability to procure long lead items like wood doors, hardware, mechanical equipment etc. is not grounds for implementing liquidated damages.

The University will evaluate and approve project extensions due to lead times on any material items outside the Contractor's control. The University will not implement liquidated damages when such approvals are made.
