

COVID-19 RULES - EFFECTIVE MAY 5, 2020

As you are aware, we are going to be having our first race under the new COVID-19 Social Distancing Guidelines. Please bear with us as this is new for everyone. The rules may lighten some regarding spectators depending on how this week's race goes. We need to get an idea of what we are looking at and crowds before we allow extra people into the gates. How the rider's and their pit crew handle themselves with the social distancing guidelines will determine when we allow spectators to come. Please stay in your pit area and do not congregate in groups of more than 10 people.

Motocross is an activity conducted at an outdoor, well-ventilated, fresh-air facility situated on tens of acres. The decision to host any event of any size or to restrict, modify, postpone or cancel an event is based on a thorough risk assessment. The WHO recommends organizers take into account specific features when assessing the risks of their event. These include: • Crowd density • Nature of contact between participants • Indoors vs. outdoors • Registered vs. non-registered participants • Age of participants and their potential to be in a high-risk group • Profession of the participants and their possible previous exposure • Number of participants coming from out of state in areas affected by the COVID-19 outbreak • Duration of the event . The goal for a motocross rider is to NOT come into contact with another rider. Given the key considerations above, motocross is a lower risk sport.

We hope to see you at our event. But your health and safety are most important to us. Here are some things you need to consider before your visit: • Ambulance and medics onsite the entire day • Advance registration preferred to avoid contact with our staff. It's fast, easy and safe • Receive registration paper at front gate and return completed to Registration. • Bring your own pen for Registration. We won't share. • Adult riders and parents of minors only need attend Registration. • Protective barrier installed between staff and riders for Registration. • Cash sales require exact change. We won't give you change back.

AT ALL EVENTS: 1. Social distancing is key. All protocols are designed with that mission in mind. There are signs to remind you to stay 6 ft away from people and do not stand in groups of more than 10 people. 2. Please read all the information we post regarding our events. If you are sick or have been sick – STAY HOME. 3. Staff will be screened for symptoms prior to each event. 4. We will have hand sanitizers and soap on site. You may also buy a mask from the concession stand. 5. Staff members in direct contact with patrons will wear masks and either wear gloves or sanitize hands after contact with others. 6. All doors, windows, workstations, equipment and

restrooms will be sanitized before, during and after an event. 7. Hand sanitizer stations located near the restrooms and there is an outdoor sink at the front gate.

The CDC recommends persons who are sick with fever or cough, elderly or at high risk to stay at home. We do too. Please do not attend our event • Please take your temperature before you leave home. If you have a temperature of at least 100.4 you have a fever and should stay home. • If you know you have had contact with someone diagnosed with having COVID-19 in the last 14 days, please stay home. • Respect our local community – wear gloves and wash hands if supporting our local businesses • We know this all sounds awful, but it's for your own good and all concerned.

SINGLE-DAY EVENT:

In addition to the above best practices for All Events, the following will be implemented for Single-Day events:

Front Gate Admission:

1. Drive-through entrance only; participants remain in vehicle
2. Staff will use hand sanitizer and/or glove change after each vehicle
3. Guests will be given a handout with the release of liability printed on one side and the race sign-up form on the back
4. You will take your signed gate release form and race entry form to the sign-up building
5. Exact cash only is accepted for the gate entry. We will not give change back. (We will consider it a tip if you don't have exact change. 😊)
6. Gates will open at Noon and sign up will also begin at Noon. Early gates will be open from 11AM-12PM for \$5 extra per car for those who want a particular parking spot.
7. Gate Fees: 10 year olds & up is \$10, 5-9 year olds is \$5, kids under 4 is Free.
7. If you leave, you have to stop at the gate so she can document who is leaving and who is in the car. You will be required to pay again if you leave. You will also not be able to bring any additional people into the gate when you return. So, don't think you can leave and go pick up people. They won't be able to come in.
8. Spectators are welcome but please maintain social distancing and stay home if you are sick.

Parking:

1. Vehicles must park leaving no less than 6 feet apart on all sides
2. Parking will be monitored and enforced throughout day by staff
3. Guests will be instructed to remain in their chosen pit area unless going to/from registration, concessions or the racetrack

Rider Registration:

1. Advance registration is encouraged. There will be a link on Facebook and Instagram that you will be able to fill out for your registration form and pay online with a credit card. The advance registration will end on Friday nights at 9:00pm.
2. If you do advance registration, you will still need to go to sign-up to pick up your practice stickers. If you bought a 2020 membership online during the online registration, you will get your card at that time.
3. If you do not pre-register, you may register when you get to the track. Please bring your own pen. If you need a 2020 membership card, you will need to ask for a membership paper at the window.
4. You may use either window to pick up your practice stickers or register for the race.
5. There will be Plexiglass separating the sign-up workers and riders.
6. Please maintain 6 feet between you and the person in front or behind you.
7. Hand sanitizers will be inside and outside of window.
8. Rider must use own pen; pens will not be shared or reused.
9. On-site registration available with safety precautions in place to limit staff/rider interaction.
10. Cash sales require exact change.

Staging Area/Track Entrance:

1. No close contact. Stay 6 ft apart from other riders/mechanics.
2. Limited to rider and 1 mechanic only. No other support crew.

3. Mechanic must wear mask or face covering while in staging and on the starting line.
4. Riders must be in full gear, including helmet. DO NOT TAKE HELMET OFF WHILE IN STAGING.
5. Rider and mechanic must remain with the motorcycle.
6. Riders called one at a time to their staging position.

Spectator/Viewing Areas:

1. We have taken down the bleachers.
2. We have areas marked where people can stand to watch the race. However, you must stand 6 feet from whoever is around you.
3. Wearing a mask while in the viewing areas is recommended.
4. Viewing areas are for standing only. No chairs. Do not use chairs to save spots. No bikes in viewing area.

Trophies/Awards:

1. You will pick your trophies/awards up at the signup building.
2. We will use the right window.
3. Please make sure you are standing 6 feet from the person in front and behind you.
4. Please wait 20 minutes after your race to pick up your awards.

EMT/Security:

1. EMT and ALS unit onsite, equipped with PPE.
2. Once again, **DO NOT** come to our track if you are sick or have been sick in the last 14 days.
3. Symptomatic persons will be asked to leave.
4. Security will enforce parking restrictions.

Food & Beverage: (if permitted)

1. Maintain 6 feet between the person in front of you and behind you.
2. Exact cash sales only.
3. Hand sanitizers inside and outside of window.
4. Pre-packaged food only; no self-serve areas.
5. Condiments and napkins given directly to customers upon request only.

After the Race:

1. "Leave No Trace"
2. Be prepared to take your trash home with you. We don't want it!
3. We will give you a trash bag if you forget one.
4. Overnight camping is permitted.
5. Maintain proper social distancing after the race.
