Everyone who qualifies in a "D" class for overall awards should move up after each series. We understand some riders will never advance out of D class. Dominating Rider in beginner classes are subject to be moved up at any time. The Pit Bike Class is not a Series Class but will be ran at all races.
- Moving up on bike size from last year does not mean you are a D rider now.
- Example: If you move from a 65cc bike to 85cc bike, you would not run D class.
- NOTE: D class may not get the same awards or products at the banquet and/or races as it is a beginner class.

- *NO PIT RIDING FASTER THAN WALKING SPEED!! *RIDERS PRACTICING OUT OF CLASS OR WITHOUT BEING SIGNED UP WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- *NO REFUNDS AFTER PRACTICE BEGINS! *Riders are responsible for their parents and crew. Any rider/parents/pit crew damaging property or not following race track rules are subject to rider disqualification. Rule pertains at all times you are on track property. *IF A RACE IS CANCELLED, NO POINTS WILL BE GIVEN. The race may or may not be scheduled at a later date.
- *IF A RACE IS CANCELLED AFTER THE FIRST SET OF MOTOS ARE RUN, POINTS WILL BE GIVEN ACCORDING TO FIRST MOTO FINISH.
- *All riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied by parents or legal guardian, or an authorized adult with written, notarized permission of parents or legal guardian. We reserve the right to ask to see a copy of the rider's birth certificate. A rider's age on January 1, 2023 determines what age class he/she can race in for the year. Example: If a rider races the 50cc 4-6 class and he/she turns 7 years old anytime after Jan. 1, 2023, he/she can race the 50cc 4-6 class the entire year. This applies to all age group classes.
