** ALL classes marked with two red double stars will receive overall awards for the series but **NO FREE CARD** will be awarded. This includes all D classes, Trail Class, Pit Bike Classes, 250/450 A & Plus A. All Beginner Class Champions **MUST** move up the next series. Everyone who qualifies in a "D" class for overall awards should move up after each series. We understand some riders will never advance out of D class. Dominating Rider in beginner classes are subject to be moved up at any time. D classes will not receive the same awards.

**Moving up on bike size from last year does not mean you are a D rider now.
Example: If you move from a 65cc bike to 85cc bike, you would not run D class.**
D class may not get the same awards or products at the banquet and/or races as it is a beginner class.

PLEASE NOTE: TRAIL & PIT BIKE CLASSES WILL RACE IN THE SAME MOTO WHICH MEANS YOU CAN ONLY RACE 1 OF THESE CLASSES.

*IF A RACE IS CANCELLED AFTER THE FIRST SET OF MOTOS ARE RUN, POINTS WILL BE GIVEN ACCORDING TO FIRST MOTO FINISH.

***All riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied by parents or legal guardian, or an authorized adult with written, notarized permission of parents or legal guardian. We reserve the right to ask to see a copy of the rider's birth certificate. A rider's age on January 1, 2026 determines what age class he/she can race in for the year. Example: If a rider races the 50cc 4-6 class and he/she turns 7 years old anytime after Jan. 1, 2026, he/she can race the 50cc 4-6 class the entire year. This applies to all age group classes.**
