

Good Friday: The Great Love The next day, some people did not understand Jesus' love and decided to harm him.


Jesus was taken to a cross. Although it pained him greatly, he didn't get angry. Instead, he said:

It's the happiest day!


Jesus rose again, that means he came back to life.
