We still have many youth who are very anxious and scared to go back to the classroom full time. They've had family members die in the past year and they're worried that they will get sick.

We have youth who are behind in academics and are scared to go back. They feel like they are too far behind without the resources to get them caught up.

We have youth who are socially scared to go back. They don't know if they have friends and don't know who will be accepting of them.

We will be there every step of the way for each and everyone of them!

Help That I Needed

I live in a car with my parents. We try and get motels here and there, but most nights we are sleeping in a car.

This means we have no personal items. I don't have toys or games or even many clothes items. I also don't have school supplies.

When school was starting for the year I started panicking. I didn't have anything to take to school with me and I didn't want my friends to know that I was homeless. But I had help.

I have been going to YouthHope for awhile now. I get free meals and help with medical appointments and job training and I knew that they would help me with school supplies.

When I walked in and asked if they had any extra school stuff, they immediately took me to the classroom at the Drop in Center.

They pulled out notebooks, folders, paper, pens, pencils, rulers, dividers, and even backpacks.

They let me pick my favorite items and even helped me pick out a first day of school outfit. I have never had brand new stuff for school before.

I walked out of YouthHope excited for my first day of school. I knew that I would fit in with my peers and I felt confident that it would be a great year.

On the first day of school, my friends were complimenting

me on my brand new backpack and my new pair of shoes. They had no idea that I slept across the street in a car.

Thank you YouthHope for giving me the help I needed right when I needed it. I didn't have to wait or feel embarrassed about my situation. You guys ran to my side and helped me feel like a normal kid for the first time!

Did You Know?

YouthHope gives out 50 bus passes a month to our youth when youth are in school full time.
