



UNIVERSAL ORLANDO PACKING LIST



CLOTHING ITEMS

- Layered clothing options for everyone
- Ponchos, rain jackets, or small umbrellas
- Extra clothes for young children
- Comfortable shoes (and backup comfortable shoes!)
- Bathing suits (note: children's life vests are provided at the pools)
- Light jackets for cooler months; gloves and hats in the coldest months

GENERAL ITEMS

- Always Magical Travel Co. documents/itineraries
- Masks and back-up masks
- Phone chargers/external travel batteries
- Medicines, band-aids, hand sanitizer, and sunscreen
- Tide pen/Shout wipes, and/or small packs of detergent for clothing
- Portable fans and cooling towels in the warmer months
- Ribbon, a sign, or something else you can attach to the stroller to set yours apart
- Charging cords/cables for phones, cameras, & external batteries
- Cash for tipping: Bell Hops (\$1-\$2/bag), Housekeeping (\$5/day is standard)

PARK BAG ITEMS

- Always Magical Travel Co. itinerary
- Masks and back-up masks
- Lanyards for tickets and room keys
- Hand sanitizer
- Sunscreen
- Phone chargers/external travel batteries
- Medicines and band-aids
- Portable fans and cooling towels
- Forms of payment (cash, gift cards, credit cards)
- Photo IDs (must be shown to purchase alcohol)
- Hats/sunglasses
- Refillable water bottles, reusable straws (only paper straws are available)
- Ziploc bags, in case it rains
- Ponchos/rain jackets
- Small Snacks (granola bars, trail mix, Goldfish, lollipops & mints make everyone smile)
- Extras:
 - Bubbles or glow sticks for little ones
 - Crayon/sticker activities to use while waiting for dining

Coolers are allowed, but you may **not** bring alcohol and any kind of glass containers into the parks
