AWAY WE GO TRANSPORTATION

Away We Go is our most frequently used private transportation company. With pricing good for up to 11 guests, Away We Go offers a variety of routes between Walt Disney World, Universal Orlando, and Orlando International Airport (MCO), Sanford International (SFB), and other area attractions and destinations. The pricing for roundtrip transportation is typically around \$200, exclusive of driver gratuities. Additional legs (ie, grocery stops, travel to Universal from Disney World, etc.) are an additional cost but can be included in one reservation - easy for all!

Drivers will meet you outside the airport or at your resort's lobby and provide a ride in a passenger van directly to your next destination.



PRIVATE LIMOS & TOWN CARS

Our agency works with a few additional, trusted providers of private transportation. With private transportation, you will have direct-to-destination transportation - no additional stops unless requested by you. Car seats are available for children, baggage assistance is provided, and you'll enjoy the luxury of a private, direct ride.



AIRPORT TRANSFER INFORMATION

Your options once you've landed

MEARS CONNECT

Mears Connect is the largest private ground transportation provider in Central Florida. They offer Express and Standard transfers to and from your Disney Resort.

You will board Mears Connect in Terminal B, on level 1, ground transportation level, at Orlando International Airport.



RIDE SHARING

Another economical option is to consider downloading the Uber or Lyft app, and using their services to get you to and from the hotel. This will ensure a reasonably priced "private" transfer.

Look for "Ride App Pickup" signs on level 2 (baggage claim) in Terminal A or B.



STROLLER INFORMATION

(YES, YOU MAY NEED ONE!)

Do I really need a stroller?

All guests can plan to walk between seven and 12 miles a day while touring the parks. If you have children six years of age or younger, I recommend considering a stroller to help keep them moving with the group. While most six-year-olds have outgrown using a stroller at home, there is a lot of ground to cover at Walt Disney World and the youngest guests can tucker out easily!

Guidelines for Stroller Use:

- Strollers larger than 31" (79 cm) in width and 52" (132cm) in length are not permitted.
- Stroller wagons are also not permitted.
- A child must be removed from his or her stroller while riding on a parking lot tram. You will need to collapse the stroller to board the tram.
- You will not need to collapse the stroller to ride the Skyliner gondolas.
- Do not leave personal belongings in an unattended stroller.
- Strollers may be moved by a Cast Member due to operational needs.
- Stroller parking exists near all attractions, shows, and dining locations; children are expected to walk through attraction queues as strollers are not permitted in line

THIRD-PARTY STROLLER VENDORS

Should you choose, you may rent a stroller from a local vendor rather than renting from Disney or bringing your own

Kingdom Strollers

Kingdom Strollers has reasonable prices and a variety of strollers, but I love them most for their excellent customer service. Strollers and scooters are both available for rent. Pick-up and drop-off must be done in person either at Orlando International Airport (MCO) or at your Disney resort. Rain covers (a necessity in Orlando!), cooler bags, and parent consoles are complimentary; snack trays and hooks are an additional cost. Insurance on strollers is available for \$10-\$25 depending on the item.

Orlando Stroller

Orlando Stroller Rental offers a variety of strollers at a reasonable price as well. While they cannot leave your rental with bell services at Disney resorts, they still deliver to Disney and Non-Disney resorts for free. They also offer the option to pick up your rental at Orlando International Airport (MCO). Included in their price is a free rain cover and a small cooler, and all of their strollers come with cup holders. They also offer insurance for \$15, covering theft and any damage to the stroller.

STROLLERS FROM *Disney*

Strollers are available for rent at all four theme parks and Disney Springs. Strollers are welcomed at Blizzard Beach and Typhoon Lagoon but are not available for rent. Disney strollers are best suited for toddlers, not infants.

It's important to know that Disney strollers are hard plastic and do not recline.



Prices

Single stroller

\$15 per day with no deposit
(\$13 per day for multi-day rentals)

Double stroller

\$31 per day with no deposit
\$27 per day for multi-day rentals

**Stroller rentals at Disney Springs require a \$100 credit card deposit.*

With multi-day rentals, you can skip the rental line entirely after your first visit. Head to the stroller handout area, show your receipt, and you'll be wheeled out in no time. This also applies for park-hopping throughout the day; simply turn in your stroller at the first park and present your receipt at the next park. You'll be issued another stroller at no additional charge. (The same applies to locker rentals and ECV/ESV rentals, too.)
