Are these cars in your dream garage?

If you're a Porsche enthusiast looking to own a truly rare and collectible model, here are some of the most sought-after and exclusive Porsches ever made:

1. Porsche 911 R (2016)

- Limited to **991 units** worldwide.
- Naturally aspirated **4.0L flat-six** engine with **500 hp**.
- Six-speed **manual transmission** and lightweight construction.
- A purist's dream, combining the GT3 RS engine with a classic driving experience.

2. Porsche 911 GT1 Straßenversion (1997)

- Homologation special of Porsche's Le Mans-winning 911 GT1 race car.

- Only **20 units** were built, making it one of the rarest Porsche models.

3. Porsche 911 Speedster (1989, 2010, 2019)

- Produces **887 hp** and achieves **0-60 mph in 2.2 seconds**.
- Limited to **918 units**, making it highly desirable among collectors.

5. Porsche 935 "Street" (2019)

- Powered by a **3.8L twin-turbo flat-six**, producing **700 hp**.
- Only **77 units** were built, featuring a retro race-car aesthetic with modern technology.

- **911 Speedster:** The 911 Speedster is a sought-after and unique model, particularly in the narrow body configuration.
- **911 50th Anniversary Edition Targa:** This special edition model commemorates the 50th anniversary of the Targa model.
