Forest Park Theatre

The Forest Park Theatre is excited to announce the summer production of Measure For Measure. This will be the 3rd summer of free Shakespeare in the Park.

The performance will be hosted at the Grove at the Altenheim. There will be 6 shows. August 4th, 5th, 6th, 11th, 12th and 13th. All performances start at 5pm.

We believe that high-quality art should be available to all, regardless of economic circumstances and that art should be seen as a gift to the community.

To keep our performances free, we are currently looking for sponsors for this summer's performance. Sponsors are a critical part of bringing theatre to Forest Park. In addition, our sponsors gain valuable marketing exposure through our print, digital and event marketing.

We expect to host 1,000 - 1,500 people during our 6 performances.

Available sponsorship levels are as follows:

Producer - \$5,000

Sponsorship recognition (logo) on signage, programs, posters, flyers, social media and email. Reserved seating at performances. Producer sponsors also receive a framed poster signed by the cast and a framed costume design signed by the costume designer. Producer sponsors are invited to meet the cast after the performance

Playwright - \$1,000

Sponsorship recognition (name only) on event signage, programs, flyers, social media and email. Playwright sponsors also receive a framed poster signed by the cast. Playwright sponsors are invited to meet the cast after the performance.

Actor - \$500

Sponsorship recognition (name only) on programs and social media. Actor sponsors also receive a frame poster signed by the cast. Each Actor sponsor will be attached to an actor. They are invited to meet the cast after the performance, and connect to the actor they sponsored.

About Measure For Measure

Temporarily left in charge by the Duke, the upright and uptight Lord Angelo has decided to crack down on the city's debauchery, arresting young Claudio for impregnating his fiancée Juliet before their wedding. When virtuous Isabella, Claudio's sister, hears of his death sentence, she begs Lord Angelo for mercy. But hypocritical Angelo propositions her instead, leaving Isabella with an impossible choice: save her soul or her brother's life.

Using our powerful storytelling style, Forest Park Theatre brings its attention to one of Shakespeare's most beautiful and unsettling plays. In this timely production, lovers and leaders in disguise reveal how those in power take advantage of those without it – asking the question, can the law be both just and merciful?

About the Forest Park Theatre

Forest Park Theatre (FPT) was founded in Forest Park, Illinois by graduates and faculty of the University of Illinois, Chicago School of Theatre and Music in the spring of 2021. In that inaugural year, our free production of Shakespeare's great comedy "As You Like It" was performed outdoors at the Roos Pavilion with a multi-racial, cross-gender cast to an audience of over a thousand people.

In August of 2022, we presented an adaptation of Shakespeare's Cymbeline centered around the character of Innogen; our performances, at The Grove at Altenheim, again served over a thousand people.

Forest Park Theatre is dedicated to language-centered, meta-theatrical, multi-disciplinary, multi-lingual, and multi-cultural performances that invigorate the classical canon and create new classics for the 21st century. We are also dedicated to bringing theatre arts to the

community of Forest Park through readings, educational programs and partnerships and productions of local scripts.

FPT operates with support from the Village of Forest Park and the Park District of Forest Park. FPT has the full support of the Mayor as an integral part of bringing arts and culture to Forest Park and its neighboring communities.

We are a non-profit company through our affiliation with the Forest Park Arts Alliance. We are proud members of the Forest Park Chamber of Commerce.
