Plymouth Trail Riders Scholarship

Due March 15, 2018

Description:

One (1) \$500 scholarship will be awarded.

Eligibility:

- a. High school seniors and post-secondary students currently enrolled in higher education are eligible to apply.
- b. Applicant must be a resident of Sheboygan or Manitowoc County.
- c. Applicant must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program (i.e. 2-or-4-year college or technical college).
- d. Applicant must be enrolled in an animal/agriculture science course of study.

Requirements for Application:

- a. Two letters of recommendation from any source (employer, teacher, school advisor) **not** a relative.
- b. Application including leadership/community service and personal statement.
- c. Applicant must be a student in good standing and provide an official transcript with application.
- d. All scholarship materials must be received by the Plymouth Trail Riders, c/o Michelle Molkenhine, N6269 County Road OJ, Plymouth, WI 53073 by March 15, 2018.
- e. Final selection and awarding of the scholarship will be made by the Plymouth Trail Riders Scholarship Committee.
- f. Scholarship recipient will be notified no later than May 15, 2018.
- g. Scholarship will be paid to the recipient after one semester has been completed, and submission of an official transcript is received by the Plymouth Trail Riders Scholarship Committee.
- h. Previous recipients of the Plymouth Trail Riders Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
