Youth: 12 & under as of 1/1/18
Junior: 13-16 as of 1/1/18
Senior: 17 & over as of 1/1/18
Novice: Horse/rider combination never to have won a blue ribbon in this class prior to this show
Pony Classes: 56" & under; riders age 15 & under only

E/W* English or Western tack, rider cannot enter canter classes
