

2022 Fort Wayne Three Rivers Festival Canoe & Kayak Races

Saturday, July 16th, 2022

This year's Fort Wayne Three River's Festival Canoe & Kayak Races will be a loop course starting and ending at the Riverside Gardens Park in Leo-Cedarville. Paddlers will put their boats in the water at the Leo boat ramp across Grabill Road from the park and proceed downstream (left from the boat ramp) to the Grabill Road Bridge. Lining up at the Grabill Road Bridge paddlers will proceed upstream to the Roth Road Bridge (2nd bridge after the start), turn around the bridge pylon, and return to finish downstream crossing under the Grabill Road bridge. Course distance is approximately 8 miles.

The awards ceremony will be held at the Riverside Gardens Park immediately following the completion of the races.
