You are invited to participate in the Fort Wayne Canoe and Kayak Races. All races start and finish at Shoaff Park Boat Ramp, 6401 St. Joe Road, Fort Wayne, IN 46835 on the St. Joseph River, GPS coordinates: N 41 8.748', W 85 6.002'.

Course and Start Times: All USCA classes run a 9-mile loop course traveling downstream to the St. Joe Center Road Bridge, then upstream to a buoy, and back downstream to the finish at Shoaff Park. The St. Joe River is deep in this area, with a mild current. The course is mostly deep water which should encourage some pack racing.
