**Water:** It is very important to have drinking water in your boat, you will get thirsty!

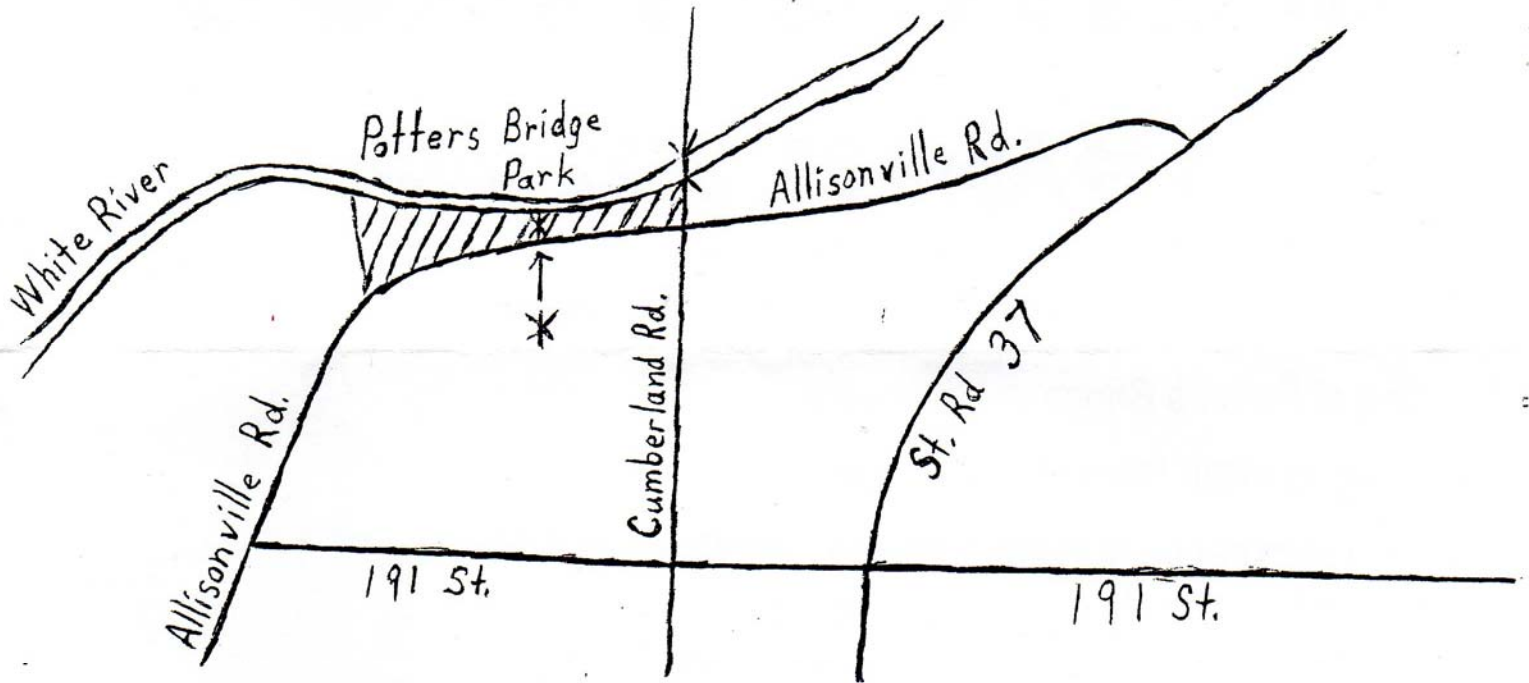
## **Drawing and Prizes!**
