



## Understanding Dignity and Safeguarding Level 2

The aim of this qualification is to support anyone who is responsible for the safeguarding of individuals by providing awareness and understanding of the key principles of dignity, duty of care and safeguarding as it applies to health and social care.

### What knowledge will be gained?

This course offers an opportunity to increase your understanding and knowledge of the key principles of dignity and safeguarding in an environment where you have a duty of care. The course explores the core principles that relate to dignity and safeguarding and how they are applied in everyday work situations and examines the dilemmas that can arise and the consequences when these principles aren't upheld.

### How is the course assessed?

You will receive an information pack and the resource to enable you to give written responses to questions in a work booklet, either handwritten or typed depending on your preference.

### What will be studied?

The course is split into 4 units:

#### **Unit 1: Understand safeguarding in adult health and social care**

Exploring legislation, policies and guidelines, the types of abuse and how to recognise the, reporting procedures, how to reduce the likelihood of abuse and where to seek information and advice.

#### **Unit 2: Principles of dignity in adult health and social care practice**

Exploring issues relating to dignity, self-worth and well-being, how to apply the principles of dignity and gain an understanding of the importance of professional relationships.

#### **Unit 3: Understand duty of care in adult health and social care**

Exploring issues relating to duty of care, possible conflicts and dilemmas faced between duty of care and individuals' rights and unsafe practices.

#### **Unit 4: Understand dilemmas and public concerns in adult health and social care**

Exploring issues of public concern and wider issues, media, perceptions and changes to service delivery.

### Who can apply?

Courses are funded for people who are aged 19 years or over, have lived in England for the past 3 years and who are not currently accessing any other government funded training.

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
