



NCFE Level 3 Award in Education and Training

The qualification provides an introduction to teaching and aims to meet the needs of a range of trainee teachers, such as: Individuals not currently in a teaching or training role, individuals currently teaching and training (including those who have just begun teaching and training) and individuals currently working as assessors who wish to achieve a qualification that provides an introduction to teaching.

What will be gained?

The NCFE Level 3 Award in Education and Training is an introductory teaching qualification. Depending upon the optional units chosen, a learner will either need to take part in microteaching (Unit 02) or teaching practice in the work environment (Unit 03 and Unit 04). Therefore, it may be undertaken by individuals who are not in a teaching role if the microteaching option is taken. The optional units will be discussed with the trainer prior to starting to ensure the correct route is achieved.

How is the course assessed?

The course is delivered over 10 weeks of which full attendance is required. There will also be self-study comprising of research and set assignments during the 10 week programme. Learners will **either** plan and deliver a micro teach session **or** be observed delivering a teaching session.

What will be studied?

The course is split into:

Mandatory Units:

Understanding Roles, Responsibilities and Relationships in Education and Training.

Understanding Assessment in Education and Training.

Optional Units-ONE of the following:

- 2: Understanding and Using Inclusive Teaching and Learning Approaches in Education and Training
- or**
- 3: Facilitate Learning and Development for Individuals
- or**
- 4: Facilitate Learning and Development in Groups

Who can apply?

The cost of the course is £650 (payment plans available) and is for people who are aged 19 years or over.

Progression routes

Successful learners can build up experience of assessment practice to progress on to NCFE Level 4 Award in Education and Training or NCFE Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment.
