By the time this newsletter is published, they will have just concluded their Team WA Training Camp, bringing together more than 100 athletes with intellectual disability and/or autism spectrum disorder, alongside 30+ coaches and volunteers across 10 sports from around the state. The camp is an important step in preparing their athletes to travel to Melbourne later this year to proudly represent Western Australia at the National Games.
