Centre for Women's Safety and Wellbeing

On Tuesday 25th November, thousands of Western Australians came together at the Centre for Women's Safety and Wellbeing's **35th March Against Domestic and Family Violence**.

Phoenix

On Tuesday 4th November, Phoenix was proud to host a **full day Masterclass** for the community services sector, titled "The Pathologisation of Sexual Abuse", with special guest trainer Dr Jessica Taylor. Dr Taylor is a British psychologist, bestselling author, and campaigner specialising in trauma-informed, anti-victim blaming approaches to supporting and protecting women, girls, and boys from violence, abuse, and exploitation. She is a regular expert advisor for international television, as well as an advisor for the UK Government, and for many years has trained Police and Barristers.

Transfolk WA & Living Proud

On the 29th of November, Transfolk WA and Living Proud will be marching in the **2025 WA Pride Parade**. Both will be honouring the history of Pride as a protest against the oppression of LGBTQ+ people in different ways: Living Proud will be marching under the theme of "Protesting with Pride", and Transfolk WA's float will include a van painted to resemble a brick in homage to the Stonewall Revolution (Transfolk will be marching under the theme of "Hopes and Dreams for Trans Liberation"). Both floats will include **protest-style signs**, with Transfolk's float including many painted here at CWLH by community members.
