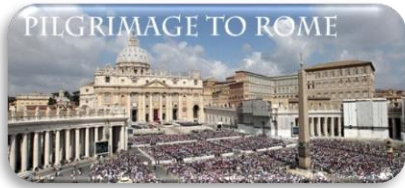

After 31st October 2025 the price will be £1680 pps.

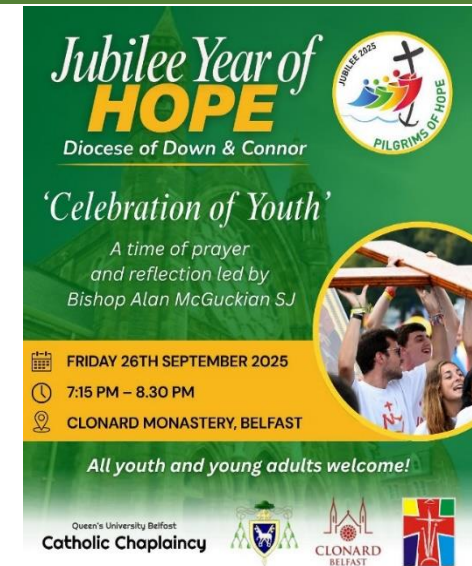
