## Celebrating 50 years of St Michael's Parish Pilgrimage to Rome



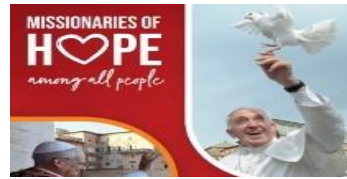
Among the events to celebrate the 50th anniversary of St Michael the Archangel Parish next year, St Michael's is offering an exclusive 5 day pilgrimage to Rome Monday 5 - Friday 9 October 2026 with Fr Ciaran Feeney PP. The price is £1580pps (with a £300 single room supplement) early bird price with a £300 pp deposit to be paid before 31st October 2025 securing your place. After 31st October 2025 the price will be £1680 pps.

The price includes airport coach transfers and return flight to Rome from Dublin, four nights' accommodation at the Villa Aurelia ([www.villaaureliaroma.com](http://www.villaaureliaroma.com)), a welcome drink on arrival, city tax, two dinners, buffet breakfast and portorage.

All the entrance fees and coach transfers are included. Guided pilgrim sites include:

- Basilica of St Peter
- Church of St Michael and St Magnus
- St Mary Major with a visit to the tomb of Pope Francis.

Daily Mass will be provided.
