Our July Meeting

We will be working during May and June on mapping inclusive activities, and also focus on the following topics to report back to the group at our July meeting.

- We will find out more about **Community Connections Services** in East Surrey delivered by Waythrough for adults (formerly Richmond Fellowship).
- Developing **autism friendly spaces** for children, young people and adults who are isolated in their local communities often rarely leaving their home.
- Finding out more about inclusive activities and adjustments offered by **local leisure centres** for autistic and neurodivergent people.
- We are planning some **evening meetings for autistic adults during June and July** to explore the further development of peer networks for autistic people. We will email autistic people on our mailing list with further details.
- We will find out more about opportunities offered through the **Surrey Local Offer**, make contact with **Autism All-Stars**, and find out more about **Carers Cards and alert cards**.
