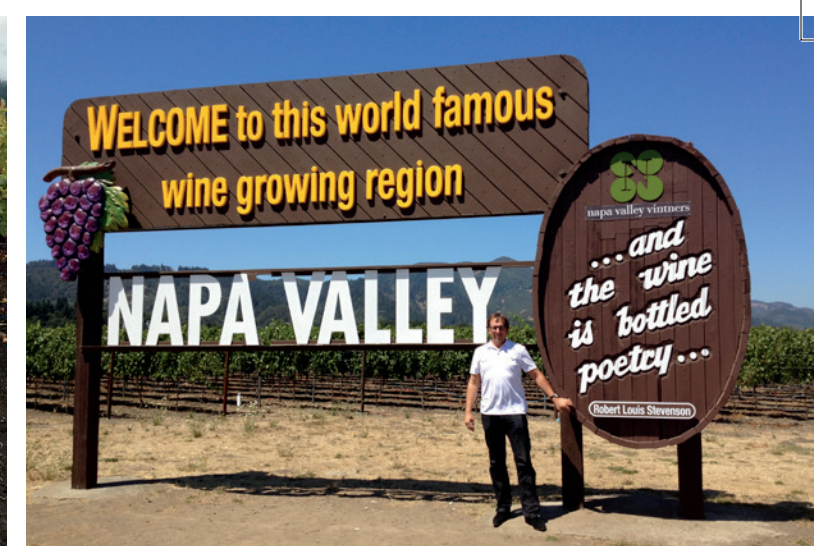

The "Judgment of Paris"

Napa Valley wines are regarded as some of the finest wines produced in the world. Beginning in the 1960's, a number of winemakers in California aspired to create wines that could rival the great wines of Bordeaux and Burgundy, which they so greatly admired. These wines were their standards of excellence, which they bought, drank, studied, and emulated. By the early 1970's, a number of producers made wines that they believed were outstanding.

In 1976, Napa Valley wine producers were invited to a wine tasting held in Paris, France. The competition was arranged as a blind tasting and included the most prestigious French wines of the time. Incredibly enough, the judges ranked a California red wine number one among the ten red wines present at the tasting. Furthermore, Napa Valley white wines were named three of the four top raking wines in this exclusive tasting.

The results of the Judgment of Paris, as this infamous tasting became known, were not ignored. From that moment forward, Napa Valley wines have rivaled the best wines in the world. The recognition that Napa Valley wines earned decades ago was only the beginning of numerous competitions these wines continue to win.

Today, the desire to constantly improve the quality and to become more in-balance with nature is now an underlying focus of many of the Valley producers. Once again, Napa Valley producers are on the leading edge with farming practices that abide by Certified Organic and Biodynamic standards for the health of our environment as well as our customers.

The diverse terrain and many micro-climates of Napa Valley create the opportunity for these grapes to become some of the most valuable in the world. 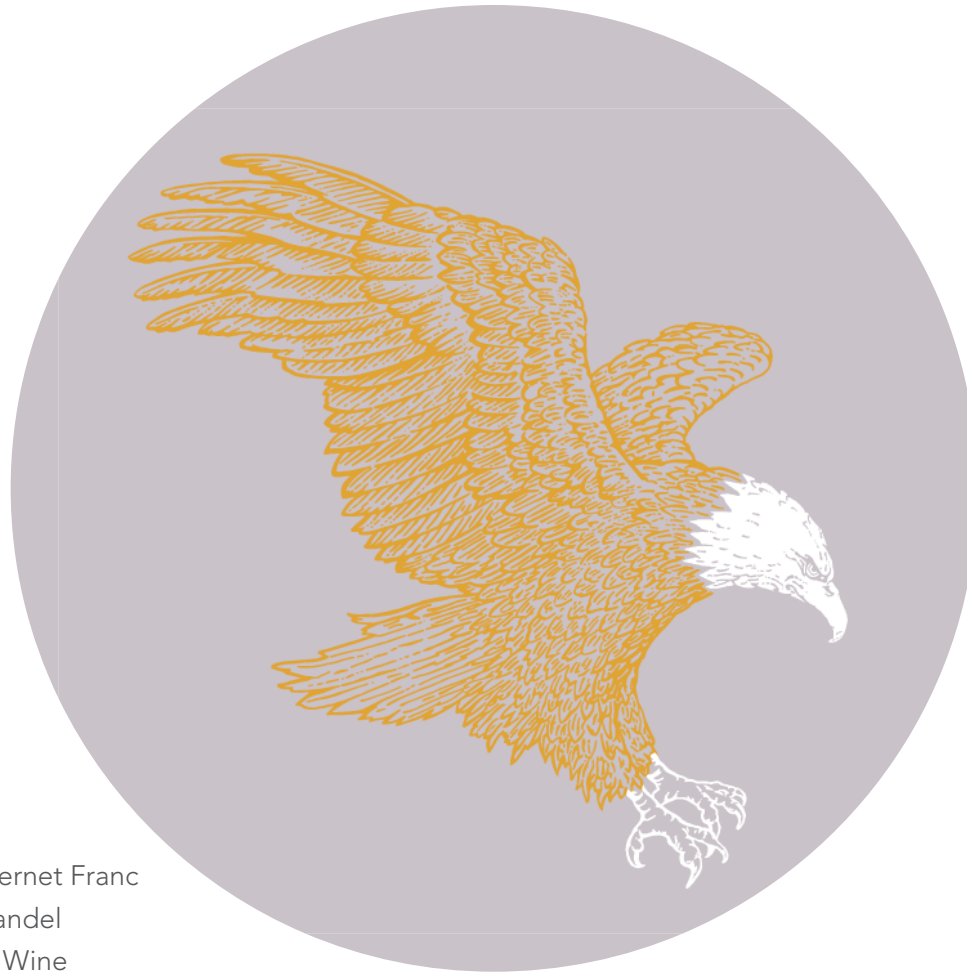

HOW WINE IS MADE

RED WINE GRAPES



Red wine grapes
Harvested between September and October each year.

DESTEM/CRUSH



Removing stems from grapes and breaking the skins of the grapes.

FERMENTATION



Skins and juice are fermented to alcohol and pump over occurs for color extraction

PRESS



Extracting all juice from the must and skins before barrel aging.

BARREL AGING



BOTTLING



WHITE WINE GRAPES



White wine grapes
Harvested between August and October each year.

DESTEM/CRUSH



Removing stems from grapes and breaking the skins of the grapes.

PRESS



Extracting all juice from the must and skins before barrel fermentation.

FERMENTATION



Juice is fermented to alcohol before barrel aging.

HOW WINE IS ENJOYED

Many people will cork a bottle of wine an hour or so before drinking because it allows the wine to "breathe" (react with the air) and will in a short time enhance the taste of most wines. This is why people will often say that their wine starts to taste better as they drink. Wine will keep after it has been opened for a day or two without changing the flavor drastically. However, the longer wine sits it will start to lose its taste and turn into vinegar.

Wine should be enjoyed by sipping out of a stemmed wine glass. Wine glasses are thin and totally clear so the vibrant colors of the wine will shine through. Wine glasses should be held by the base of the glass not the bowl as many people do.

THE LOOK:

The color of wine can tell you a lot about its type and is best examined in the glass against a white background. You will find that young

red wines appear to be rich and blue-purple and older red wines appear to be a rusty brownish red. White wines can range in color from a greenish yellow to a vibrant gold.

THE SMELL:

Swirl the wine gently in the glass, holding it by the stem. This action will release the decedent aroma that is so characteristic of wine. By putting the tip of your nose into the glass and lightly inhaling, the scents can trigger memories & familiar scents that will allow you to describe what you smell in abstract terms.

THE TASTE:




Take a sip of the wine, but do not swallow. Let the wine roll around all parts of your mouth, for it will feel different on your cheeks than it will on your tongue. As you swirl the wine in your mouth, try to define whether it tastes sweet, sour, bitter, alcoholic, or grassy.

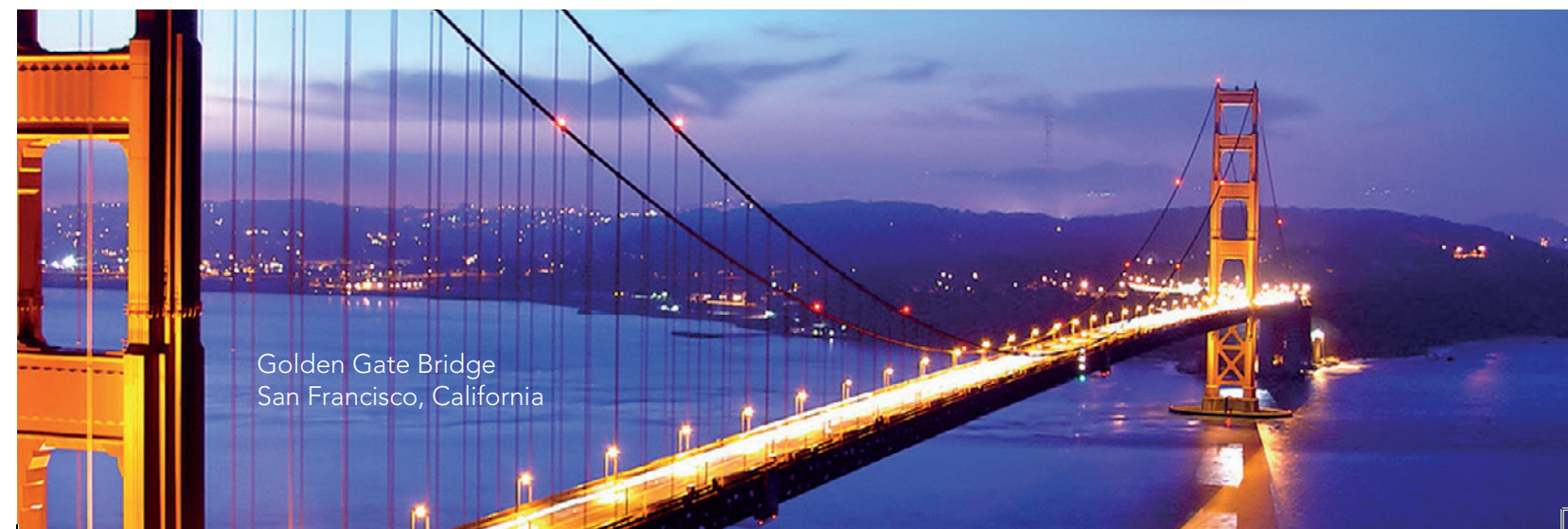
SHIPPING AND BULK WINE
