*** We will be camping a HULAH Lake this Year ***

You will ride the historic trails of yesteryear in the beautiful Osage Indian Nation, along the Kansas-Oklahoma border. Cowboys still roam the huge ranches in that area. Riding the fences & checking cattle herds like the cowboys in the 1800's.

All paid reservations received by May 1st, will be entered in a drawing for a free ride in 2021 Fees: <u>\$100.00 for 3 days (if paid by May 1st)</u> Fee after May 1^{st :} <u>\$120.00</u> Less that 3 day reservations are \$40.00 per day

Emergency refunds are at the discretion of the Trail ride Committee! This fee covers (7) meals (there will be no Sunday evening meal) & beach privileges at Hulah. You are responsible for your pool expenses at Osage Park. Transportation will be provided each evening, back to previous camp, to get trucks & trailers. HORSE FEED WILL NOT BE PROVIDED. Visitors & drivers are welcome for all meals (<u>@\$6.00 per plate</u>) & camping. They may join the Cook Wagon Caravan during the day.

DIRECTIONS TO THE CANEY ARENA: Caney, KS is located 20 miles west of Coffeyville, KS on HWY 166, or 20 miles north of Bartlesville, OK on US HWY 75. When you enter Caney, you will be on HWY 75, go west on 6th street approximately 1 mile to the edge of town. After you cross the railroad tracks, follow signs to entrance of Caney Saddle Club Arena.

WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU CHECK IN ON THURSDAY AFTERNOON, IF YOU ARE COMING FROM A DISTANCE. You may camp at the Arena Thursday night if you like. There are no electric hook-ups, water is available for watering your horses. There is NO shade at the arena for horses or humans if you come in Thursday this is why we encourage afternoon/evening check in on Thursday. So please plan accordingly.

Bagged Ice will be available for purchase, at Hulah & Osage Hills campsites.

FRIDAY:

6:00 AM CHECK IN:

<u>7:45 AM</u> RIDER MEETING (all riders to assemble in the Arena) for a brief meeting to explain the <u>Ride</u> <u>Rules</u>, <u>Camp Rules</u> and last minute announcements. MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A WAY TO CARRY WATER FOR YOURSELF ON THE RIDE, WATER JUG OR BOTTLES OF WATER

<u>8:00 AM</u> START OF RIDE: (PLEASE BE READY TO LEAVE ON TIME) We will begin our exit from starting Camp, and head for Hulah Lake, approximately 20 miles to the Friday camp. Mullendores' Crossbell Ranch will be the majority of the ride Friday.

<u>2:00 PM</u> APPROXIMATE ARRIVAL TIME AT HULAH Lunch will be served upon arrival at camp. Immediately after lunch, a bus will be provided to take you back to the Caney Arena to retrieve your rigs.

<u>PARK RULES : "NO HORSES ARE ALLOWED IN AREA FROM THE ROAD TO THE LAKE SHORE"</u>. All Park /Rules will be announced at Riders meeting and will be enforce

Water & Electric hook-ups are available at Hulah, across the road from the horse camp, (NEXT TO LAKE SHORE) "<u>at your expense</u>". The designated horse camp (NON-SHORE SIDE OF ROAD) is complimentary of the Caney Saddle Club.

7:00 PM SUPPER WILL BE SERVED and evening activities will begin after supper.

SATURDAY:

6:00 AM BREAKFAST WILL BE SERVED

<u>8:00 AM (SHARP)</u> WE'LL LEAVE CAMP Saturday ride is approximately 28 miles, ranch riding very similar to Friday.

<u>12:00</u> LUNCH meet the Cook Shack for lunch from 12:00 – 1:00.

<u>3:45PM</u> APPROXIMATE ARRIVAL TIME AT OSAGE HILLS. Upon arrival riders will be taken back to Friday's camp to retrieve your rigs.

Osage Hills camp is primitive, with electric and water hook-ups (at your expense) about 1 mile from the horse camp. Water for horses will be available in camp.

Riders and family may use the pool upon arrival at camp (at your expense). The pool closes at 8:00 PM. Remember Supper will be served at 7:00PM.

7:00PM SUPPER WILL BE SERVED.

SUNDAY: (Last day)

6:00 AM Breakfast will be served.

8:00 AM (SHARP) LEAVE CAMP Sunday's ride is approximately 22 miles, also Ranch riding. **12:00** LUNCH We'll meet the Cook Shack for lunch and hit the trail again at 1:00PM. **2:45PM** APPROXIMATE ARRIVAL TIME AT PAWHUSKA. The ride ends at the Osage Trading Co. on US HWY 99. Upon arrival riders will be taken back to Saturday's camp, to retrieve your rigs.

The ride management is always open to suggestions for improvements to make the ride more enjoyable, so everyone will come back again & again. We are very proud of the fact that some of our riders were on the very first ride in 1960, and some of our rider's parents were the pioneers of this great event. It is not surprising to find a rider that may have made this ride 15 or 20 times. With this in mind allow us to list some simple rules.

1. All riders must sign Liability Release Form: signature of parent or guardian required for minors.

2. CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS PAPERS ARE REQUIRED: ORIGINAL COPY WITH HORSE MARKINGS. Electronic copies are ok, but will be looked at my check-in members. Be ready to present them on check- in

3. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the trail. <u>You may have alcoholic beverages at your camp, as long as</u> <u>You are not disruptive.</u>

4. NO STALLIONS ALLOWED.

5. ONE RIDER TO AN ANIMAL, AND NO ANIMALS WITHOUT RIDERS.

- LEADING OR TYING ONE ANIMAL TO ANOTHER IS NOT ALLOWED... EACH RIDER MUST BE ABLE TO RIDE HIS OR HER OWN HORSE.
- 7. Smoking on the trail will be restricted according to weather.
- 8. DO NOT PASS THE TRAIL BOSS
- 9. Keep the gaps closed throughout the group PLEASE. If a club member asks you to close up a gap, please cooperate. NO STRAGGLERS. IF YOU ARE IN TROUBLE, LET US KNOW. WE WILL DEAL WITH YOUR NEEDS. There is no marked trails, the land we are crossing is working ranches. SO PLEASE STAY UP WITH THE GROUP.
- 10. YOUR HORSES AT HULAH MUST REMAIN ON THE (NON-SHORE SIDE OF THE ROAD). DO NOT WATER AT THE LAKE. WATER FOR ANIMALS IS PROVIDED.
- 11. DO NOT WATER IN THE PONDS.

- 12. NO DOGS ALLOWED on the trail. Dogs are allowed in camp, on a leash or in a kennel, as long as they are not disruptive to riders and horses.
- 13. If you do not follow the rules, you will not be allowed to finish the ride. If you have a problem, contact the trail boss.

DO NOT FORGET PLENTY OF WATER FOR THE TRAIL!!!

****We recommend that you stock up on needed supplies & gas/fuel before leaving Caney, there are NO convenient stores near the campsites.

Bagged Ice will be available for purchase, at the Hulah & Osage Hills campsites, for your convenience.
