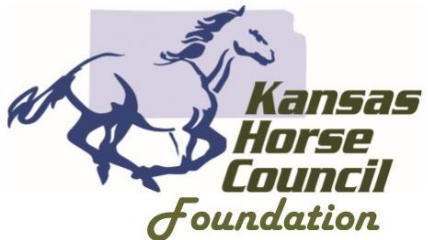
**SAVE THE DATE FOR OUR ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING,

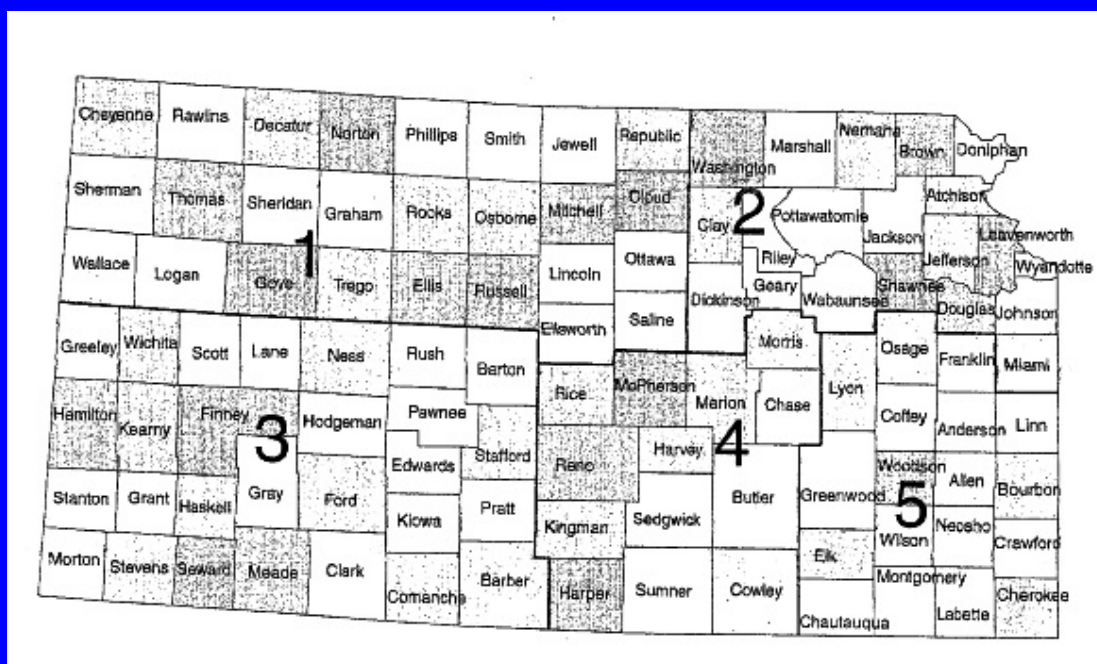
**KANSAS HORSE COUNCIL MEETINGS HELD ALL ACROSS

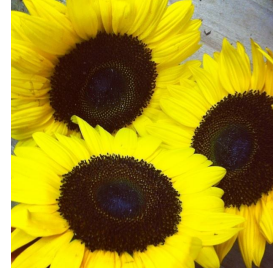
