Waiver and Release:

I understand that equine activities are inherently dangerous given the nature of horses, their size and the risks that accompany riding, including but not limited to outside trails, indoor and outdoor arenas, and/or in clinics or competitions. in nature. I expressly assume all risks associated with the same. As a condition precedent to participating in this event, I agree that I will not, on my behalf or on the behalf of any minor children of mine, bring litigation or claim for damages of any kind, including personal injury or death, against the Kansas Horse Council, its Board of Directors, Members or Volunteers, Sponsors, Clinicians and/or the Premise Owners upon whose land I ride (hereinafter collectively "the Released Parties"), including those instances arising from the alleged negligence of the Released Parties.

WARNING

"Under Kansas law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of domestic animal activities, pursuant to K.S.A. 60-4001 through 60-4004. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity. Inherent risks of domestic animal activities include, but shall not be limited to:

- (1) The propensity of a domesticated animal to behave in ways, i.e. running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them;**
 - (2) the unpredictability of a domestic animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;**
 - (3) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions;**
