- 11:00 AM Leave Campground for an easy 1-hour guided ride on Jackalope & Wild Horse Trails.
- 12:00 PM Catered lunch.
- 1:00 PM Dedication & Sunflower Chapter BCHKS welcome.
- 1:30 PM Auction to fund fire pit, grill shelter/pad & other campground improvements.
