CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Tenants are responsible for their visitors. No large parties, loud music or unruly behavior is allowed.
- 2. Pets are allowed at campgrounds. However, pets must be kept on a leash, cleaned up after, and not left unattended at campsites.
- 3. Alcohol is permitted only at your campsite. Excessive use will not be tolerated. Underage drinking, drug use, or illegal activity of any kind will be reported to the Lyon County Sheriff's Dept; offenders will be banned from the campground. The City reserves the right to remove tenant from campsite without any refund for violations of the provision.
- 4. The City and its employees are not responsible for damage, vandalism or theft of Tenant's RV/Camper/Trailer or other personal possessions. This includes "Acts of God" (i.e. damages from storms, floods, etc). Tenant understands the City and its employees are not liable, nor responsible, to carry insurance coverage on camping units, vehicles, or other personal property. Tenant agrees he or she is responsible to carry his/her own liability/comprehensive insurance during the length of stay.
- 5. The City reserves the right to inspect all sites. Any Tenant in violation of the rules and regulations will forfeit their lease and all monies paid and will be required to leave immediately.
- 6. Quiet time begins at 9:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 10:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.
- 7. Speed limit is 10 MPH. There are a lot of small children at the playground area and we want to keep them safe.
- 8. Maximum stay at a campsite is 2 weeks. Camper must be moved after that.
- 9. Camping Season is from Mid April to October 1st each season.
- Campsite must be paid for within 30 minutes of setting up your camper. Camping fee is \$15/night and can be dropped off in the City Office Drop Box with your name and phone number.
