Within these pages, you will find documentation of this year's work on behalf of veterans and their families.

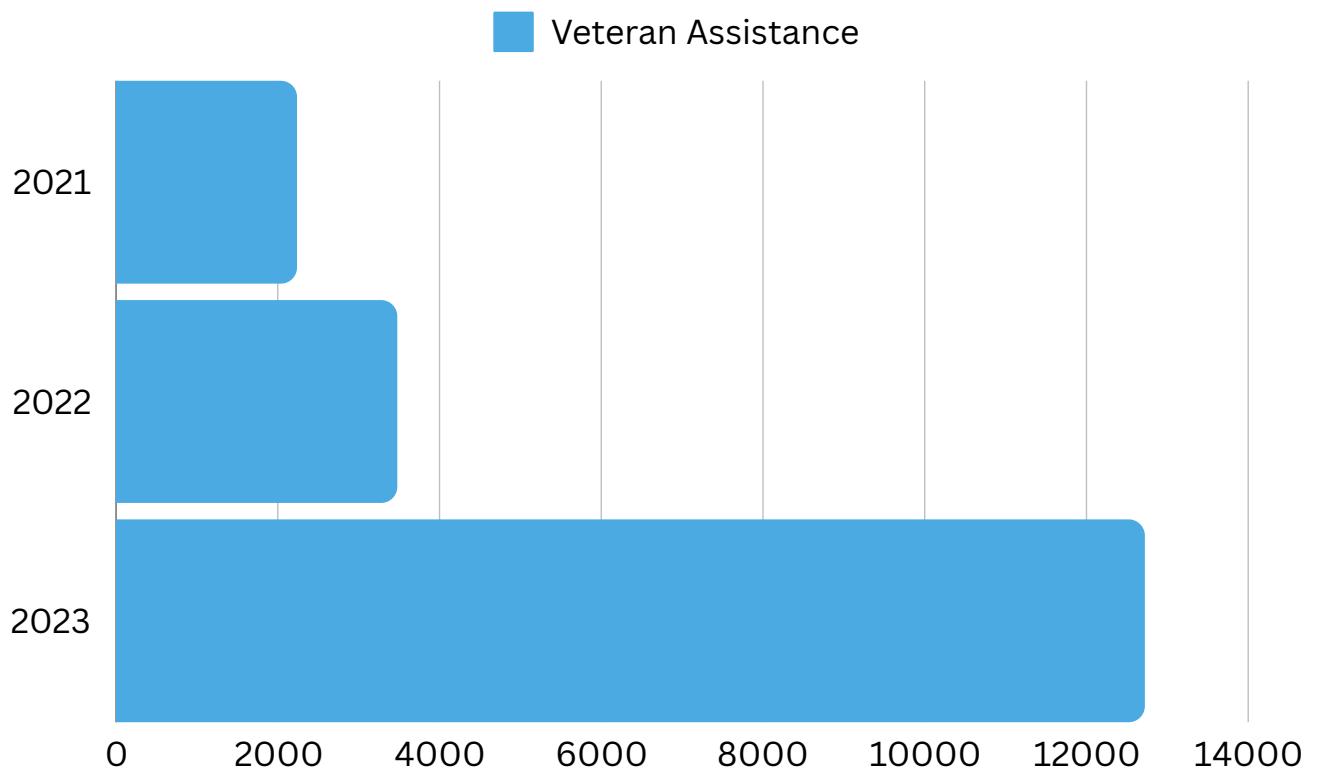
ORGANIZATION PROFILE

As you can see, the needs have multiplied exponentially over the last three years.

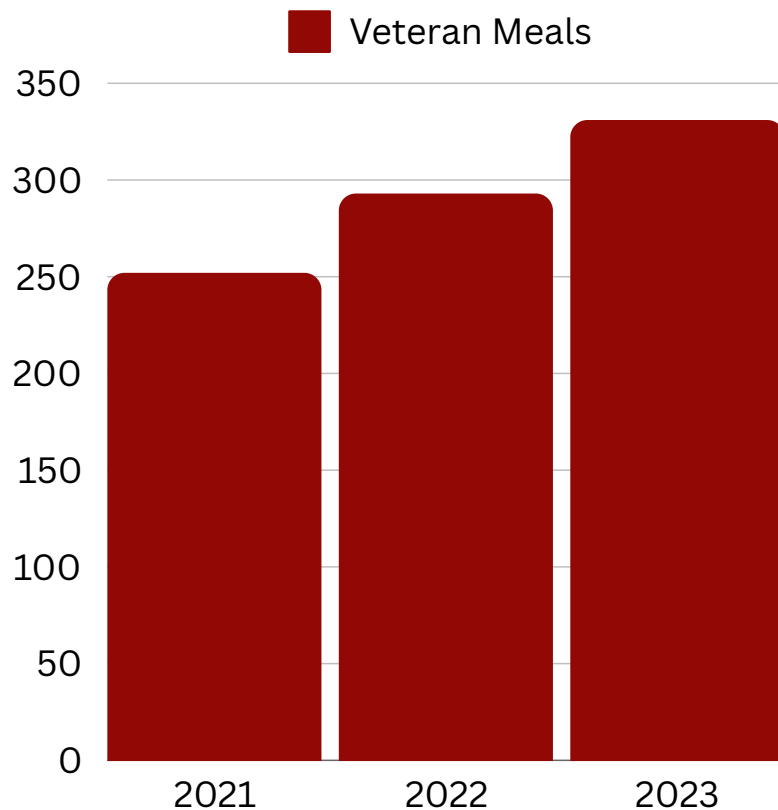
In 2021 we provided \$2238.00 in veteran assistance.

KS 4 Vets provides monthly meals and annual dinners for veterans and their caregivers. In addition to this, supplemental food is provided for those in need.

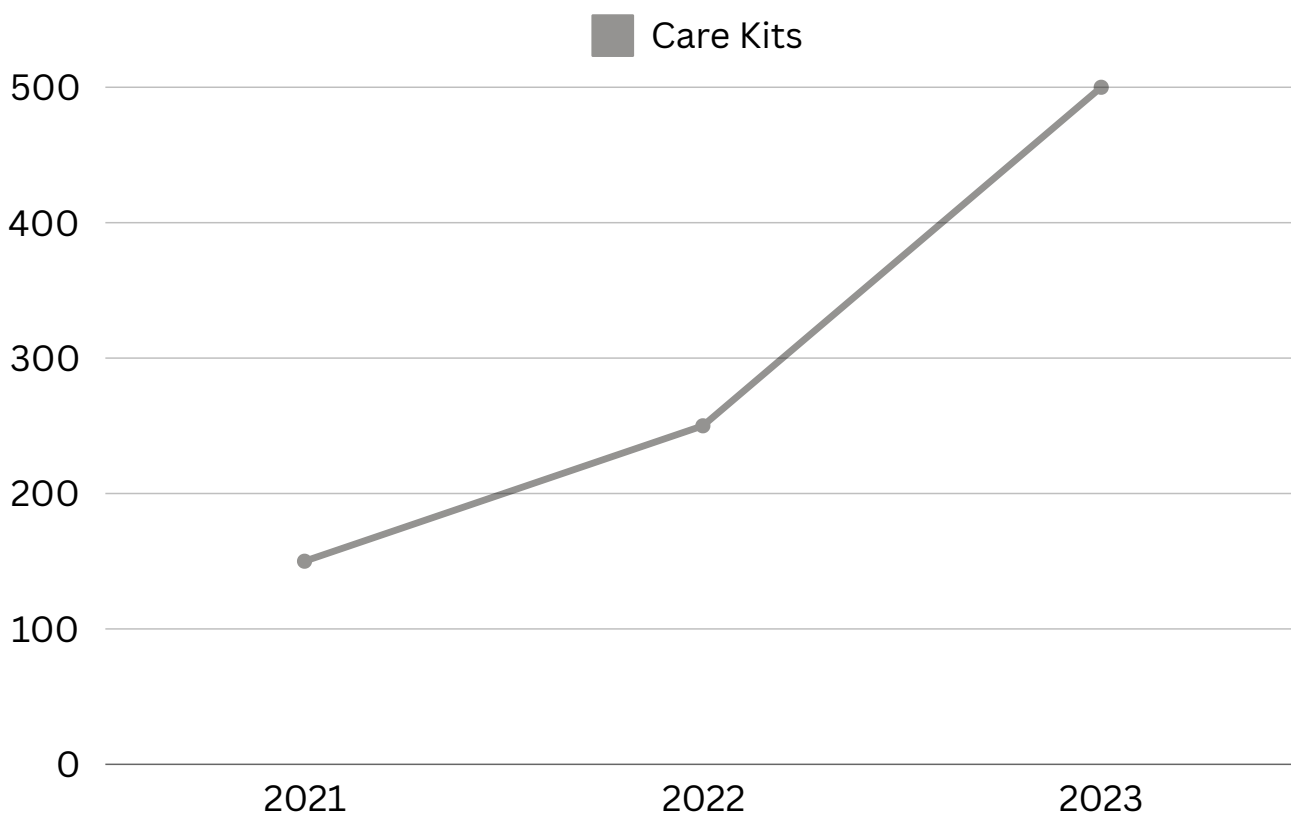


Year Totals

As you can see, the outreach with meals has steadily grown over the last three years. In 2021 we provided 252 veteran and caregiver meals. In 2022 we provided 293 veteran and caregiver meals. In 2023 we provided 331 veteran and caregiver meals.

KS 4 Vets has completed many supply drives over the years, including the fall Warm Up War and the winter Deployed Tree. In partnership with other businesses and the Salvation Army items were collected and packaged by volunteers then distributed through Robert J. Dole VA Center's Homeless program, Fort Dodge and Winfield Soldiers Homes, 6 counties of VFWs and American Legions, and Passageways, a transitional housing program..
