



Care Instructions

Chapel Equipment with ChapX Luxury Laminate

For routine care, clean the surface with a damp cloth or sponge and a mild soap or detergent. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and wipe dry.

Difficult stains such as coffee or tea can be removed using a mild household cleaner/detergent and a soft nylon brush repeating, as necessary. Finish by rinsing with warm water and wiping dry.

If a stain persists, use a paste of baking soda and water, and apply with a soft nylon brush. Light scrubbing for 10 to 20 strokes should remove most stains. Although baking soda is a low abrasive, excessive scrubbing or exerting too much force could damage the decorative surface, especially if it has gloss finish.

Stubborn stains that resist any of the above cleaning methods may require the use of undiluted household bleach or nail polish remover. Apply the bleach or nail polish remover to the stain and let stand no longer than two minutes. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and wipe dry. This step may be repeated if the stain appears to be going away and the color of the laminate has not been affected.

Prolonged exposure of the laminate surface to bleach will cause discoloration.

Recommended Household Cleaners

- Liquid dish soap like Dawn
- Windex
- Glass Plus
- Fantastik
- Mr. Clean
- Formula 409
- Isopropyl Alcohol (Isopropanol)

Caution

- Acidic or abrasive cleaners – like scouring powders, Ajax, Comet, and Magic Eraser can damage laminate surfaces; do not use them.
- Abrasive pads – like scouring powders, steel wool, Scotch-Brite, sandpaper, and other abrasive pads will damage the laminate. Do not use them for cleaning.

Prayer Kneeler Fabrics

ChapX Prayer Kneelers are upholstered in a fabric which uses the following cleaning code:

W – Spot clean only with water-based upholstery shampoo or foam cleaner. Pretest a small inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not get over wet. Do not use solvents to spot clean. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming, or light brushing with a non-metallic, soft bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam-to-seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains. When an overall soiled condition has been reached and professional care is required, contact an IICRC certified firm (www.iicrc.org).



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Chapel Chairs

Frame

ChapX Chapel Chair frames are powder coated which not only looks great, but also helps extend the life of your chair. To ensure the long life of your chair, a simple and regular maintenance program should be implemented. Here are three simple steps to keep your ChapX chair frames looking great!

- Carefully remove any loose surface deposits with a wet sponge by gently rubbing.
- Clean by gently rubbing the surface with a soft brush (non-abrasive) and diluted solution of a mild detergent (example: pH-neutral liquid hand soap or dishwashing detergent such as Dawn) in warm water to remove dust and other deposits. For stubborn stains use only recommended solvents in the affected area such as Isopropyl alcohol (IPA) or methylated spirits. Rinse off with clean water and dry with a soft cloth. Do not use other aggressive solvents.
- Rinse the surfaces with clean fresh water after cleaning to remove all residues.

Caution

- Do not use turpentine, white spirits, thinners, citrus based cleaners, petroleum-based cleaners, or other aggressive solvents on powder coating.
- Do not rub powder coated surfaces excessively, especially metallic finishes.
- It is universally recognized that some sunscreens adversely affect powder coated finishes.
- Non approved solvents can cause damage that may not be visible immediately and may take up to twelve months to appear.

Fabric

ChapX Chapel Chairs are upholstered in a fabric which uses the following cleaning code:

W – Spot clean only with water-based upholstery shampoo or foam cleaner. Pretest a small inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not get over wet. Do not use solvents to spot clean.
