YEAR TO 20th NOVEMBER 2022.

- I should wish to express my thanks to our outgoing Captain, Peter McGeever for all his help and advice in my first year as treasurer. I am very grateful to my assistant treasurer, Maureen Sullivan, for keeping me on the correct path with her wealth of knowledge about the people and traditions of the Society, for purchasing the prizes, to collecting the money and for often writing out the cards just before we all go out to play golf. Without doubt the most valuable member of this society.
- I wish to express my thanks to all our Sponsors who have generously provided all the prizes for our days out this year.
- We have changed our bank account from AIB, who advised the Society that they were
 closing our account because of a change in Bank policy. We eventually managed to open a
