Eligibility

All work must be original in concept and not copied from another artist's work. Works should be executed in the past three years (April 2017-2019), and not previously exhibited at this show during this time.

Specifications

Maximum accepted size (including frame) is 40"X40".

All works accepted be in original, completed condition, ready to hang with substantial wiring. NO saw-toothed hangers will be allowed.

Frames, mats and wiring must be of professional quality, and in good condition.

Continued.....

Wiring MUST be substantial enough for the weight of the artwork.

All paintings must be framed or gallery wrapped.

Photography and two-dimensional works on paper must be framed and under glass or polycarbonate.

All works must be tasteful and appropriate for a family audience.

Liability

Works are entered at the artist's own risk. Artwork will be handled with reasonable and prudent care. The Avinger Chamber of Commerce and its representatives will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks while on display. Owners and/or their agents shall agree, and hold this organization harmless/blameless for any loss by signing appropriately provided forms.

Artists are responsible for collecting and reporting any sales tax upon the sales of their work.
