THE KALALAU TRAIL

Ha'ena State Park

One of the most adventurous hiking trails in the world. The first 2 miles of the trail to Hanakapi'ai Beach is a popular day hike. Day-use reservations are required to access the trail, visit www.gohaena.com

The trail begins at Ke'e beach, this is a beautiful beach with a lifeguard posted.



KILAUEA LIGHTHOUSE

At3500 Kilauea Road, Kilauea, HI 96754

The lighthouse is 52 feet situated 180 feet above the Pacific Ocean. The lighthouse was commissioned in 1913.

SOUTH SHORE / POIPU



SPOUTING HORN

A blow hole located near Poipu. It is impressive to watch the ocean rise through the lava rock.



PUKA DOG

A unique Kauai experience.

POIPU BEACH

A popular beach with a shallow, protected swimming area. Turtle sightings are common here



ANAKE'S JUICE BAR

The islands best acai bowl with fresh fruit. It is located inside Kukuiula Market.



TREE TUNNEL

A lush canopy provides a beautiful entrance to the South Shore.

EAST SIDE / KAPAA



WAILUA FALLS

Beautiful waterfall that you can drive up to and park to enjoy the view.



BIKE PATH

A bike path along the coconut coast stretching 7.3 miles.



LYDGATE BEACH PARK

Located in Wailua, a popular beach that has two rock-enclosed ponds creating a safe haven from the ocean.



PASSION BAKERY

An east side bakery with delicious goodies such as malasadas and macadamia nut sweet rolls. Malasadas are only available on Tues, Thurs, and Sat.



OPAEKAA FALLS

A waterfall that is easily accessed by car alongside the Wailua River.



WAILUA RIVER

The river is on the east side of the island. It offers many activities like kayaking, hiking or the fern grotto. Make kayak rentals in advance.

WEST SIDE / WAIMEA



HANAPEPE

Kauai's "Biggest Little Town". The Swinging Bridge is great to see. There are also several art galleries to visit.



KAUAI COFFEE

The largest coffee farm in the U.S. You can take a free walking tour.



WAIMEA CANYON

Known as the Grand Canyon of the Pacific. There are many beautiful lookouts and hikes



SALT POND BEACH

A beautiful lifeguarded beach. Swimming is usually safe in the sem-protected ocean water.



POLIHALE

The final beach along the Na Pali Coast. This is a beautiful long stretch of beach. The road can be rough.



JOJO'S SHAVE ICE

Traditional and homemade, Jojo's is a great place to cool off with a delicious shave ice.
