8:00 p.m.	<b>EXODUS AND LEVITICUS</b> Course: The course is a continuation of the study of the Pentateuch, and attention is given to the mission of Moses, plagues, Passover, Exodus and the journey to Sinai, the Decalogue, the Tabernacle... 9:00 p.m.	<b>REVELATION</b> Course: The practical values of the book are emphasized, the various methods of interpretation are given, and literal vs figurative applications are studied. The text is analyzed with specific attention given to historical background (apocalyptic and first century), along with contemporary issues like eschatology and premillennialism. 7:00 p.m.	<b>HEBREW HISTORY</b> Course: The course studies Israel's history following the periods of Egyptian slavery and wilderness wandering and it explores Israel from its entrance into Canaan through the period of the judges.
