

Declarations of Sexual Purity

1 Corinthians 6:13b

My body is not meant for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for my body.

1 Corinthians 6:18-29

I flee from sexual immorality. I do not sin against my own body. I know that my body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within me. I am not my own, I was bought with a price. So I glorify God in my body.

2 Timothy 2:21

I am an instrument for special purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do every good work.

Colossians 3:5

I put to death whatever belongs to my earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.

Hebrews 13:4

I honor marriage, and my marriage bed will be kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.

Romans 13:14

I clothe myself with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh.

Psalms 119:9

I stay on the path of purity by living according to God's Word.

Matthew 5:8

I am pure in heart, and I am blessed, for I will see God!

1 Thessalonians 4:1-5
