# The Peace of God



### What is God's Peace?

**God's Peace,** in the new testament, is the Greek word "**Eirene**" a verb, from the word "**eiro"** = to join or bind together that which had been separated. It literally pictures the weaving back together of something separated or divided, and making them one. Because God binds us back together with Him, we get to experience all that His peace has to offer; safety, inner rest, clarity of mind, harmony with His plan, and freedom from fear.

This corresponds with the Hebrew word "**Shalom**" = the state of being made complete and sound. Shalom is not just freedom from trouble, but is everything that makes for a person's highest good in God, implying health, well-being, ease of mind, strength and prosperity. As a result of placing our faith and trust in the gospel of Jesus Christ, we are reconciled to God, and get ALL of His benefits!

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#### **Governed by His Peace**

On this earth, we will walk through the valley of the shadow of death, yet, we will fear NO evil. Through every difficulty, challenge, sadness and sorrow, we are comforted and strengthened as we choose to live by Jesus' overcoming victory.

God's full desire is to govern every nation with His peace. This IS possible to those that will truly fear His Name and honor His commands. As His eyes scan the earth, will he find a nation He can rightfully govern?

He also wants to *personally* govern every individual that calls upon His Name. His peace will come in, to anyone that will LET Him in! He wants His peace to be the governing umpire of our lives, leading us to safety, and leading all men to reconciliation with Him.
