FREEDOM FROM SIN - A NEW KINGDOM, A NEW WAY OF LIVING

Key Scriptures: Colossians 1:13-14, Romans 6:1-14, 1 John 2:1-2

Now that you're born again, you're no longer under the kingdom of darkness. Satan and sin have lost dominion over you! As a child of God, you don't have to be entangled with sin. You have renounced sin (pride, rebellion, self-will, falling short & missing the mark), and you have been **set completely free from it's power!** Walk in the newness of life and let your decisions be governed by the your **new King**, **Jesus Christ**. Your identity is no longer 'sinner,' but is now 'the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus'. Receive this new kingdom and identity!

In this kingdom, you're not focused on 'not sinning.' Your focus is on seeking Jesus and His Kingdom first. As you're working out your salvation, if you sin, know that you have an advocate (Defender, Friend, Helper) to bring you back on track. Always run TO God in repentance, not away from Him in shame. Keeping your heart humble, open and submitted to Him at all times will keep you thriving in His Kingdom. If you are aware of a sin that you need to renounce, don't be ashamed! RENOUNCE it, and find complete freedom in Him!
