2024 Charity Recipients



Childrens Discovery Museum (CDMC) Cindy Burreson (CEO)

A community resource for children and families to experience the joy of learning about themselves and the world around them through hands-on explorations of exhibits and programs. They embrace diversity, equity, and inclusion as essential to their mission. They value and support the uniqueness of every member of our community. The museum plans to reopen on or around Memorial Day 2024.

Rancho Mirage Elementary School Shane Hagar (Principal)

RMWC has been giving to this school in Rancho Mirage for many years. Budgets have been cut from the school district. Every year their needs have been greater for after-school classes. This year specifically, they need extra money to purchase "head phones" for each child to aid in their studies.

The Green Room Theatre Company David Catanzarite (Founding Artistic Director)

This theatre company creates new works, reinvented classics, musical theatre productions, touring productions, and site-specific performances for the Coachella Valley. It directs its education Programs toward young people and underserved communities.

Shelter From the Storm (SFTS)

Angelina Coe (Executive Director & CEO)

SFTS is the Coachella Valley's only comprehensive domestic victim assistance service and shelter provider. They provide services for mothers and their children who are victims of domestic abuse. They used to be totally funded by donors and had several houses for many needy mothers and children. However, due to the passing of their main donors, they are currently down to one house...but still have as many mothers and children needing their services.
