3 Functions of Cardiac Specialty Services

HHCs 1 - Front



Coordinate Care:



• Coordinate physician and caregiver communication on cardiopulmonary assessments, cardiac therapy services, and disease management

Empower with Education:

• Teach patients to manage their heart health, including prescription and diet education and adherence; symptom tracking, warning sign identification, appointment, and physician instruction reminders

Assess Cardiac Re-admits:

- Identify patients at high-risk for re-hospitalization through robust analytic tools
- Improve medical professionals' clinical outcomes
