### Item 2: Picnic August 26, 2023.

### 2.1 Financial contributions from Fox Chapel, Aspinwall, and O'Hara Democratic Committees

Allison Stein, Chair of the Fox Chapel committee reported that Fox Chapel will contribute \$250, Aspinwall will contribute \$200 and O'Hara will get in touch shortly as to its contribution.

### 2.2 Flyer invitation

Richard and Netti, including input from other committee members, put together a draft of the invite to the picnic and shared it with the committee. After much discussion it was suggested that we invite Blawnox and Sharpsburg to participate as well. Neither has a formal democratic committee, however Allison knows several key democrats in each municipality who she will contact in order to have Blawnox and Sharpsburg included as sponsors. Thus, all of the municipalities in the Fox Chapel School District are included. Ron made a motion with a second from Sara that Allison will take care of creating a flyer for the 5 other municipalities. Motion carried. ### **Item 3: Support for IT Supervisors**

The candidates have been meeting regularly, are organized and are using Vote Builder. Jonathan Neumann made a plea, for those of us in District 5, to recruit volunteers to canvass in districts 1,2,3&4 since district 5 is not up for election this year. It was also suggested that we ask Sam from ACDC, or Congressman Chris Deluzio, to MC the introduction of our 4 Supervisor candidates at the picnic. It would be good to have a script for the introductions. Candidates will send to democrats the link for mail in ballots. Will also develop candidate slate card. It was also suggested that the slate card and information about mail in ballot be sent to families who may have college age children.

#### From Jonathan

The ACDC Chair, Sam Hens-Greco has been encouraging Democratic Committees in the county to hold what he calls "House Party" fund-raisers in support of the functioning of the ACDC. On Wednesday July 26 I attended on of these hosted by Pittsburgh 14<sup>th</sup> Ward committee – see Slide 1 below.

Sam is encouraging us to join in with Shaler to host a house party fund raiser, but that will have to wait until after the Municipal election.

Sam and Morgan Overton, ACDC Vice Chair, gave a good presentation on accomplishments of the past year outlined on slides 2 and 3 below. Note the effort to support Democratic candidates for school board – Slide 3.

Funding for the past year came from several contributors, but in large part from an un-named contributor who made a major grant. I believe that individual was out of state and had a big interest in seeing last year's midterm get a lot of Democratic supporters to turn out. I liked the way that Sam instituted a "Voter Guide" listing bios on all the candidate in the primary, instead of just a slate card of the endorsed candidates. *The ACDC mailed out two hundred thousand of those guides*. I think the endorsement procedure may be in for a change going forward.

Sam and Morgan will put in an appearance at the picnic, and Sam is willing to introduce our four candidates for township supervisor if we give him a short script.

Sam is really searching for funds to pay for the canvassing help and mailings to dems in the county. They can't expect large grants to materialize to handle tha costs. There are boroughs and city ward in the county that do not yet have Democratic Committees. Sam has found people willing to start committees in some Wards and Boroughs and can appoint members in those instances. If he could get monthly contributions of \$5 or \$10 from members of the each of the 160 plus Democratic committees in the county, then funding would be solved. There is a QR Code on slide 2 and 3 that allows you to make a monthly recurring donation to ACDC.

The ACDC has only one paid employee, Emily Marburgher, and her health insurance in covered by her husband's employer.


